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Projections of the U.S. Population 2000 to 2050


Overall, the U.S. population will continue to grow, increasing from 282.1 million in 2000 to 419.9 million in 2050. However, the rate of increase might be the slowest since the Great Depression of the 1930s as the size of the “baby boom” population continues to decline.

The nation’s projected 49% population increase during the next 50 years would be in sharp contrast to most European countries, whose populations are expected to decline by mid-century.

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Greater Diversity in the United States Population

- The Asian and Hispanic population will triple over the next half century.
- The Asian population is projected to grow 213%, from 10.7 million in 2000 to 33.4 million in 2050. Their share of the nation's population would double from 3.8% to 8%.
- The Hispanic population will grow from 35.6 million to 102.6 million, an increase of 188%. Their share of the population would nearly double from 12.6% to 24.4%.
- The Black population is projected to rise from 35.8 million to 61.4 million in 2050, an increase of 71%. That would raise their share of the U.S. population from 12.7% to 14.6%.

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


Black Alone Population Projections 2000 to 2050



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
Asian Alone Population Projections 2000 to 2050



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
All Other Races Population Projections 2000 to 2050



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
Hispanic Population Projections 2000 to 2050



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White Alone Not Hispanic Population 2000 to 2050




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


Percent Distribution 2000 to 2050



Black Alone Population Percent of Total U.S. Population




Asian Alone Population Percent of Total U.S. Population



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
Hispanic Population Percent of Total U.S. Population














Percent White Alone Not Hispanic Population Age 65 and over



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
Percent Black Alone Population Age 65 and over



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
Percent Asian Alone Population Age 65 and over
