



Community Economic Development HotReport

To help communities prepare for the impacts of base realignment and closure (BRAC), the Employment and Training Administration (ETA), the Economic Development Administration (EDA), and the Office of Economic Adjustment (OEA) supported the U.S. Census Bureau's efforts to develop an interactive web-based report that would capture information from a variety of agencies and databases. The HotReport gives communities a baseline of relevant indicators about their circumstances, derived from the detailed statistics below. HotReports display information in charts, maps, and tables. The HotReport is made up of several interconnected dynamic web pages. Information comes from a number of sources, including the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages; the Census Bureau's Local Employment Dynamics (LED), Census 2000, American Community Survey, Population Estimates, Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates, and County Business Patterns; and the Department of Education's Common Core of Data and Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System. Data are maintained and updated by the collecting agency.

HotReports provide community users speedy access to comparable information for grant applications and decision making for economic development.
