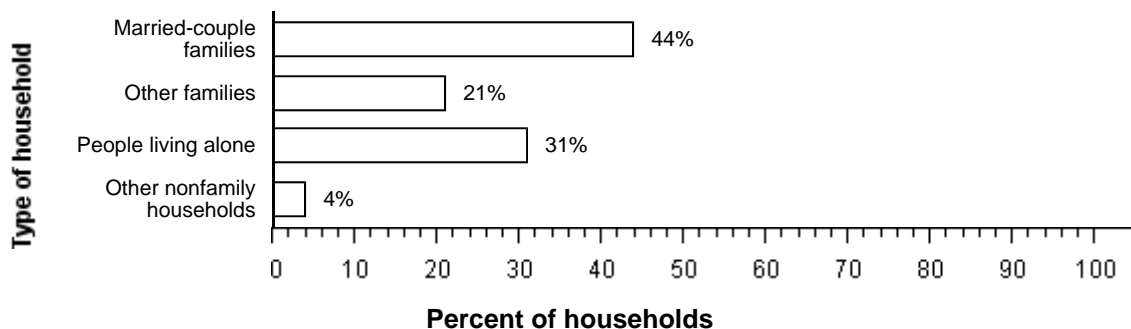
NOTE. HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES: In 2006 there were 34,000 households in PUMA 00305. The average household size was 3 people.

Families made up 65 percent of the households in PUMA 00305. This figure includes both married-couple families (44 percent) and other families (21 percent). Nonfamily households made up 35 percent of all households in PUMA 00305. Most of the nonfamily households were people living alone, but some were composed of people living in households in which no one was related to the householder.

The Types of Households in PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006

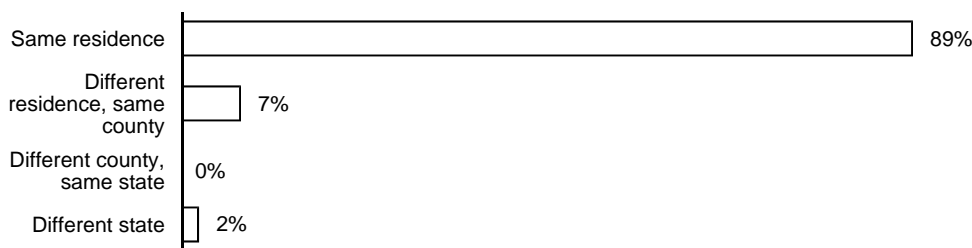


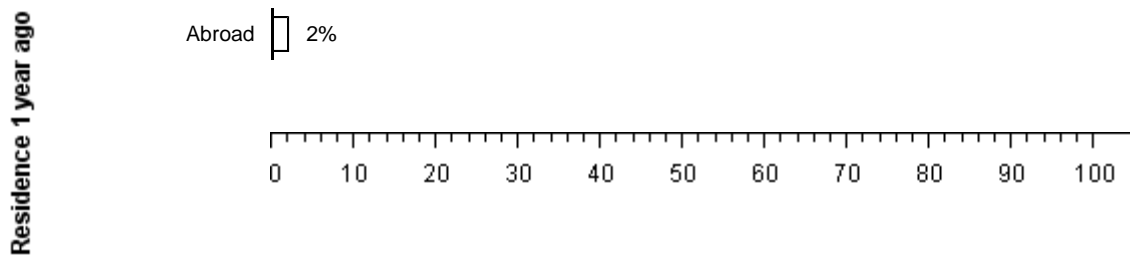

NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE: Data for this section cannot be displayed because the number of sample cases is too small. Displaying the data would risk disclosing information for individuals.

GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY: In 2006, 89 percent of the people at least one year old living in PUMA 00305 were living in the same residence one year earlier; 7 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, less than 0.5 percent from another county in the same state, 2 percent from another state, and 2 percent from abroad.

Geographic Mobility of Residents of PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006





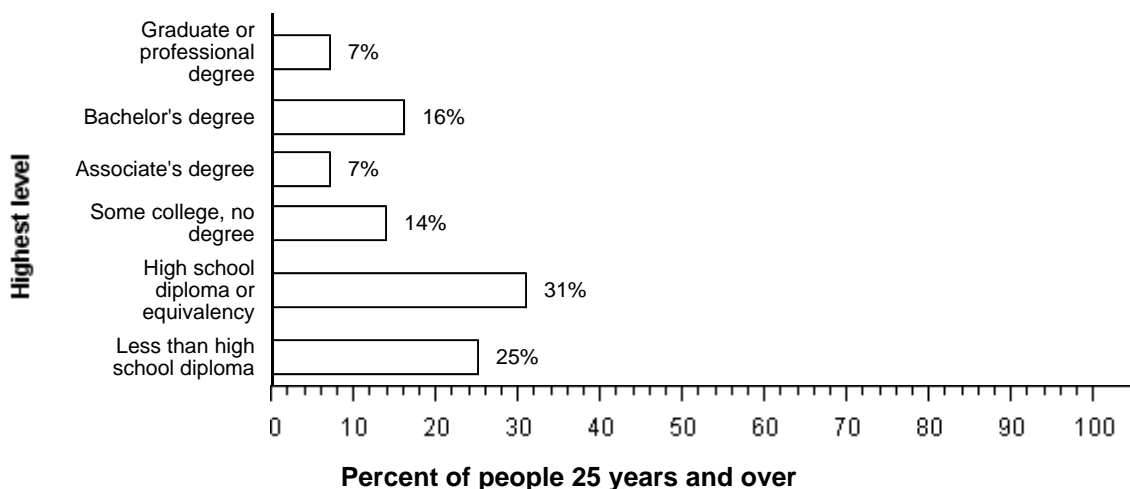
Percent of people age 1 year and over

EDUCATION: In 2006, 75 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 24 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Twenty-five percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in PUMA 00305 was 23,000 in 2006. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was 2,500 and elementary or high school enrollment was 15,000 children. College or graduate school enrollment was 5,100.

The Educational Attainment of People in PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006

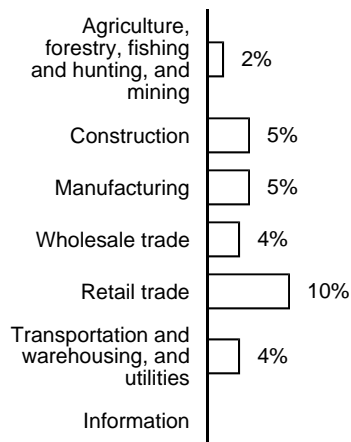


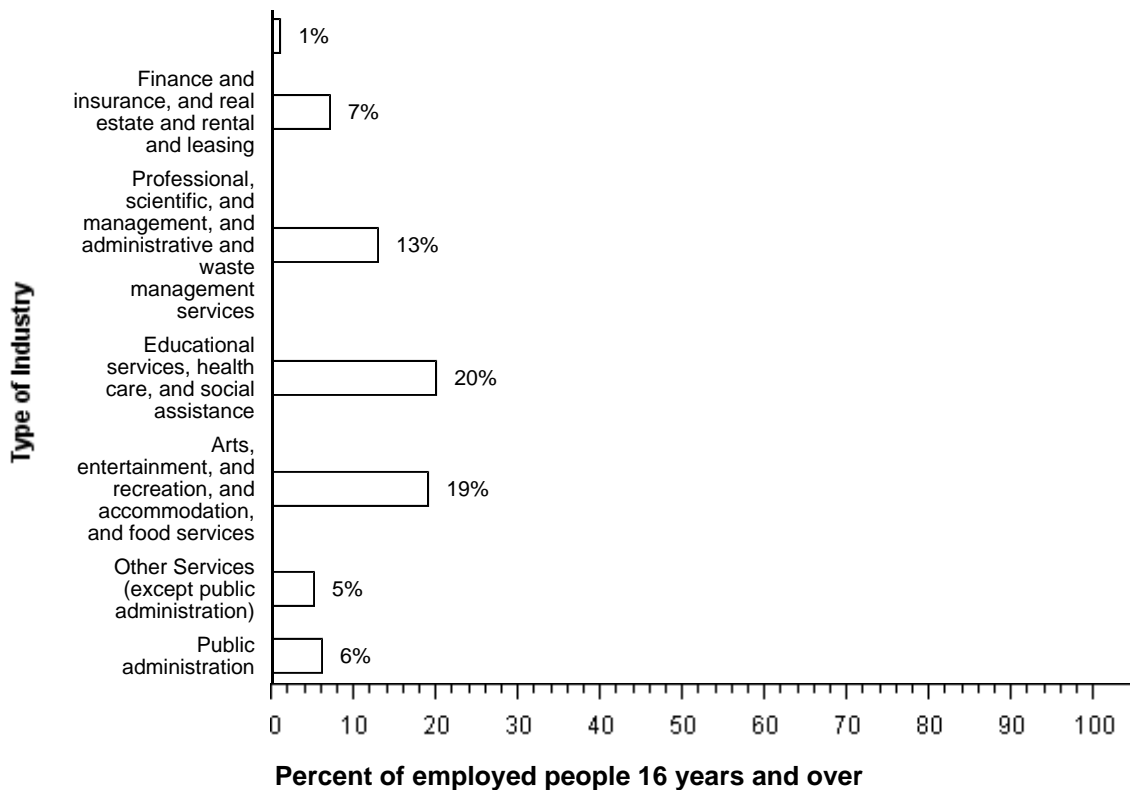

DISABILITY: In PUMA 00305, among people at least five years old in 2006, 14 percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from 2 percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to 10 percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to 35 percent of those 65 and older.

INDUSTRIES: In 2006, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in PUMA 00305 were Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 20 percent, and Arts, entertainment, and recreation, and accommodation, and food services, 19 percent.

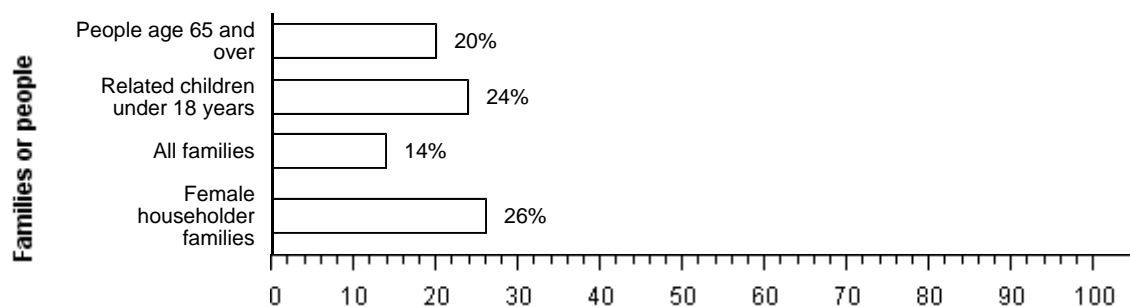
OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER: Among the most common occupations were: Service occupations, 31 percent; Management, professional, and related occupations, 28 percent; Sales and office occupations, 22 percent; Construction, extraction, maintenance and repair occupations, 10 percent; and Production, transportation, and material moving occupations, 7 percent. Eighty percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; 15 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and 5 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

TRAVEL TO WORK: Forty-seven percent of PUMA 00305 workers drove to work alone in 2006, 17 percent carpoolled, 19 percent took public transportation, and 13 percent used other means. The remaining 3 percent worked at home. Among those who commuted to work, it took them on average 22.1 minutes to get to work.

INCOME: The median income of households in PUMA 00305 was \$48,352. Seventy-five percent of the households received earnings and 19 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. Thirty-six percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$12,656. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS: In 2006, 20 percent of people were in poverty. Twenty-four percent of related children under 18 were below the poverty level, compared with 20 percent of people 65 years old and over. Fourteen percent of all families and 26 percent of families with a female householder and no husband present had incomes below the poverty level.

Poverty Rates in PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006

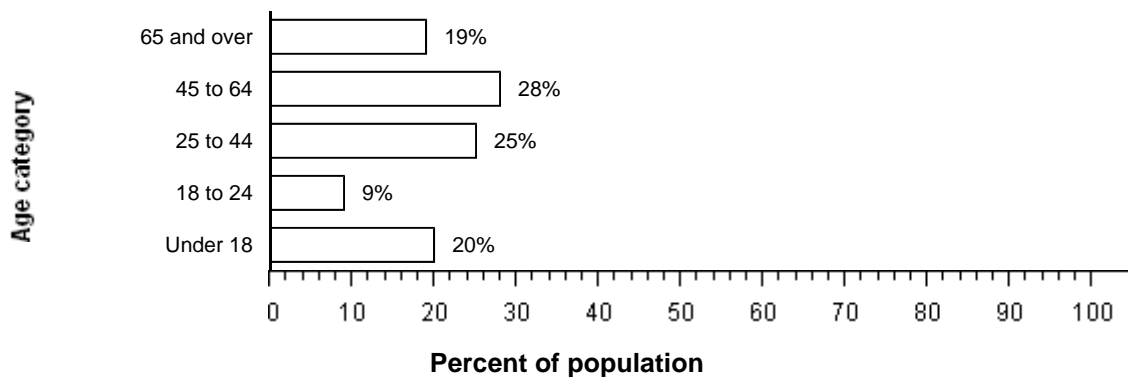


Percent below poverty level

POPULATION OF PUMA 00305: In 2006, PUMA 00305 had a total population of 107,000 - 53,000 (50 percent) females and 53,000 (50 percent) males. The median age was 42.9 years. Twenty percent of the population was under 18 years and 19 percent was 65 years and older.

The Age Distribution of People in PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006

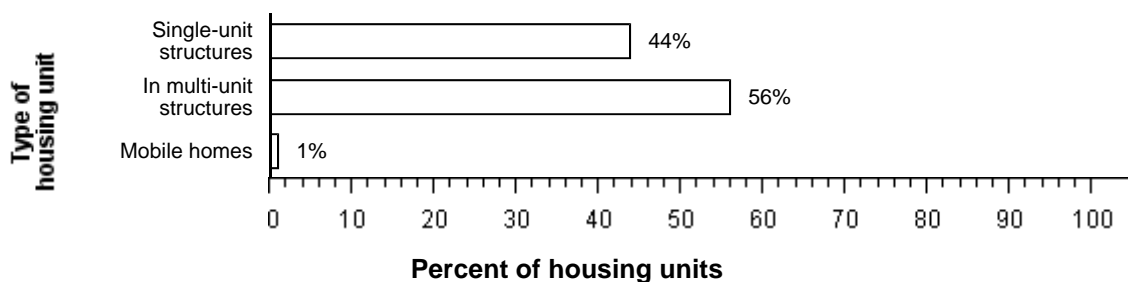

For people reporting one race alone, 13 percent was White; 1 percent was Black or African American; less than 0.5 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 76 percent was Asian; 10 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and less than 0.5 percent was Some other race. Thirteen percent reported Two or more races. Three percent of the people in PUMA 00305 was Hispanic. Ten percent of the people in PUMA 00305 was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS: In 2006, PUMA 00305 had a total of 37,000 housing units, 7 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 44 percent was in single-unit structures, 56 percent was in multi-unit structures, and 1 percent was mobile homes. Ten percent of the housing units were built since 1990.

The Types of Housing Units in PUMA 00305, Hawaii in 2006

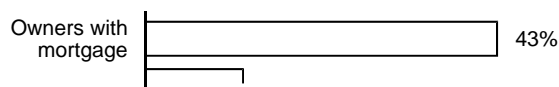


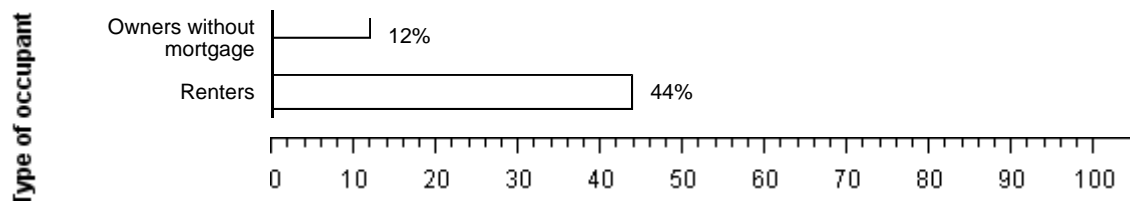

OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS: In 2006, PUMA 00305 had 34,000 occupied housing units - 16,000 (47 percent) owner occupied and 18,000 (53 percent) renter occupied. Four percent of the households did not have telephone service and 22 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Twenty-two percent had two vehicles and another 13 percent had three or more.

HOUSING COSTS: The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$2,024, nonmortgaged owners \$394, and renters \$811. Forty-three percent of owners with mortgages, 12 percent of owners without mortgages, and 44 percent of renters in PUMA 00305 spent 30 percent or more of household income on housing.
