
NOTE. HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES: In 2007 there were 39,000 households in PUMA5 00303. The average household size was 2.6 people.

Families made up 70 percent of the households in PUMA5 00303. This figure includes both married-couple families (54 percent) and other families (16 percent). Nonfamily households made up 30 percent of all households in PUMA5 00303. Most of the nonfamily households were people living alone, but some were composed of people living in households in which no one was related to the householder.

The Types of Households in PUMA5 00303, Hawaii in 2007





GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY: In 2007, 89 percent of the people at least one year old living in PUMA5 00303 were living in the same residence one year earlier; 8 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, less than 0.5 percent from another county in the same state, 3 percent from another state, and less than 0.5 percent from abroad.

EDUCATION: In 2007, 93 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 43 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Seven percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in PUMA5 00303 was 21,000 in 2007. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was 3,500 and elementary or high school enrollment was 12,000 children. College or graduate school enrollment was 5,900.


The Educational Attainment of People in PUMA5 00303, Hawaii in 2007



DISABILITY: In PUMA5 00303, among people at least five years old in 2007, 14 percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from 3 percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to 9 percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to 35 percent of those 65 and older.

INDUSTRIES: In 2007, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in PUMA5 00303 were Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 22 percent, and Professional, scientific, and management, and administrative and waste management services, 13 percent.


OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER: Among the most common occupations were: Management, professional, and related occupations, 46 percent; Sales and office occupations, 26 percent; Service occupations, 16 percent; Construction, extraction, maintenance and repair occupations, 7 percent; and Production, transportation, and material moving occupations, 5 percent. Sixty-nine percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; 22 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and 8 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

TRAVEL TO WORK: Sixty-seven percent of PUMA5 00303 workers drove to work alone in 2007, 16 percent carpooled, 6 percent took public transportation, and 3 percent used other means. The remaining 7 percent worked at home. Among those who commuted to work, it took them on average 28.3 minutes to get to work.

INCOME: The median income of households in PUMA5 00303 was \$77,822. Seventy-nine percent of the households received earnings and 30 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. Thirty-eight percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$17,370. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS: In 2007, 5 percent of people were in poverty. Five percent of related children under 18 were below the poverty level, compared with 2 percent of people 65 years old and over. Two percent of all families and 4 percent of families with a female householder and no husband present had incomes below the poverty level.


Poverty Rates in PUMA5 00303, Hawaii in 2007

POPULATION OF PUMA5 00303: In 2007, PUMA5 00303 had a total population of 104,000 - 53,000 (51 percent) females and 51,000 (49 percent) males. The median age was 45.8 years. Eighteen percent of the population was under 18 years and 20 percent was 65 years and older.

The Age Distribution of People in PUMA5 00303, Hawaii in 2007



For people reporting one race alone, 28 percent was White; 1 percent was Black or African American; less than 0.5 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 64 percent was Asian; 6 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and 1 percent was Some other race. Seventeen percent reported Two or more races. Two percent of the people in PUMA5 00303 was Hispanic. Twenty-three percent of the people in PUMA5 00303 was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS: In 2007, PUMA5 00303 had a total of 42,000 housing units, 7 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 77 percent was in single-unit structures, 22 percent was in multi-unit structures, and less than 0.5 percent was mobile homes. Fifteen percent of the housing units were built since 1990.

OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS: In 2007, PUMA5 00303 had 39,000 occupied housing units - 27,000 (70 percent) owner occupied and 12,000 (30 percent) renter occupied. Two percent of the households did not have telephone service and 8 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Multi Vehicle households were not rare. Thirty-seven percent had two vehicles and another 24 percent had three or more.
