NOTE. HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES: In 2005-2009 there were 11,000 households in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County). The average household size was 3 people.

Families made up 76 percent of the households in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County). This figure includes both married-couple families (60 percent) and other families (16 percent). Nonfamily households made up 24 percent of all households in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County). Most of the nonfamily households were people living alone, but some were composed of people living in households in which no one was related to the householder.

## The Types of Households in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County), Hawaii in 2005-2009



NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE: Seven percent of the people living in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) in 2005-2009 were foreign born. Ninety-three percent was native, including 52 percent who were born in Hawaii.

Among people at least five years old living in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) in 2005-2009, 10 percent spoke a language other than English at home. Of those speaking a language other than English at home, 15 percent spoke Spanish and 85 percent spoke some other language; 27 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well."

GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY: In 2005-2009, 87 percent of the people at least one year old living in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) were living in the same residence one year earlier; 8 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, less than 0.5 percent from another county in the same state, 5 percent from another state, and less than 0.5 percent from abroad.


# Geographic Mobility of Residents of Kailua CDP (Honolulu County), Hawaii in 2005-2009



EDUCATION: In 2005-2009, 95 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 43 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Five percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) was 8,500 in 2005-2009. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was 1,000 and elementary or high school enrollment was 5,200 children. College or graduate school enrollment was 2,200.







DISABILITY: In Kailua CDP (Honolulu County), among people at least five years old in 2005-2009, percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to percent of those 65 and older.

INDUSTRIES: In 2005-2009, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) were Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 22 percent, and Professional, scientific, and management, and administrative and waste management services, 13 percent.

OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER: Among the most common occupations were: Management, professional, and related occupations, 45 percent; Sales and office occupations, 24 percent; Service occupations, 16 percent; Construction, extraction, maintenance, and repair occupations, 10 percent; and Production, transportation, and material moving occupations, 6 percent. Sixty-seven percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; 21 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and 12 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

TRAVEL TO WORK: Sixty-nine percent of Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) workers drove to work alone in 2005-2009, 13 percent carpooled, 4 percent took public transportation, and 6 percent used other means. The remaining 7 percent worked at home. Among those who commuted to work, it took them on average 27.8 minutes to get to work.


INCOME: The median income of households in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) was \$88,699. Eighty-six percent of the households received earnings and 24 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. Thirty-two percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$16,683. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS: In 2005-2009, 6 percent of people were in poverty. Eight percent of related children under 18 were below the poverty level, compared with 3 percent of people 65 years old and over. Five percent of all families and 17 percent of families with a female householder and no husband present had incomes below the poverty level.




Percent below poverty level

POPULATION OF Kailua CDP (Honolulu County): In 2005-2009, Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) had a total population of 34,000 - 17,000 (49 percent) females and 17,000 (51 percent) males. The median age was 40.9 years. Twenty-three percent of the population was under 18 years and 15 percent was 65 years and older.

# The Age Distribution of People in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County), Hawaii in 2005-2009



For people reporting one race alone, 48 percent was White; 1 percent was Black or African American; less than 0.5 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 19 percent was Asian; 6 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and 1 percent was Some other race. Twenty-four percent reported Two or more races. Six percent of the people in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) was Hispanic. Forty-seven percent of the people in Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) had a total of 12,000 housing units, 6 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 80 percent was in single-unit structures, 20 percent was in multi-unit structures, and less than 0.5 percent was mobile homes. Six percent of the housing units were built since 1990.


OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Kailua CDP (Honolulu County) had 11,000 occupied housing units - 8,100 (71 percent) owner occupied and 3,300 (29 percent) renter occupied. Two percent of the households did not have telephone service and 4 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Multi Vehicle households were not rare. Forty-three percent had two vehicles and another 27 percent had three or more.

HOUSING COSTS: The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$2,786,
