

NOTE. HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES: In 2005-2009 there were 700 households in Pepeekeo CDP. The average household size was 2.5 people.

Families made up 65 percent of the households in Pepeekeo CDP. This figure includes both married-couple families (37 percent) and other families (28 percent). Nonfamily households made up 35 percent of all households in Pepeekeo CDP. Most of the nonfamily households were people living alone, but some were composed of people living in households in which no one was related to the householder.

NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE: Fifteen percent of the people living in Pepeekeo CDP in 2005-2009 were foreign born. Eighty-five percent was native, including 71 percent who were born in Hawaii.

Among people at least five years old living in Pepeekeo CDP in 2005-2009, 24 percent spoke a language other than English at home. Of those speaking a language other than English at home, 2 percent spoke Spanish and 98 percent spoke some other language; 60 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well."


GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY: In 2005-2009, 86 percent of the people at least one year old living in Pepeekeo CDP were living in the same residence one year earlier; 9 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, less than 0.5 percent from another county in the same state, 4 percent from another state, and 1 percent from abroad.

Different



EDUCATION: In 2005-2009, 83 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 18 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Seventeen percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in Pepeekeo CDP was 310 in 2005-2009. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was 16 and elementary or high school enrollment was 240 children. College or graduate school enrollment was 53.

Percent of people 25 years and over



DISABILITY: In Pepeekeo CDP, among people at least five years old in 2005-2009, percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to percent of those 65 and older.

INDUSTRIES: In 2005-2009, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in Pepeekeo CDP were Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 24 percent, and Arts, entertainment, and recreation, and accommodation and food services, 14 percent.

OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER: Among the most common occupations were: Sales and office occupations, 25 percent; Management, professional, and related occupations, 24 percent; Service occupations, 24 percent; Production, transportation, and material moving occupations, 10 percent; and Farming, fishing, and forestry occupations, 10 percent. Sixty-four percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; 23 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and 12 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

TRAVEL TO WORK: Fifty-nine percent of Pepeekeo CDP workers drove to work alone in 2005-2009, 29 percent carpooled, 3 percent took public transportation, and less than 0.5 percent used other means. The remaining 8 percent worked at home. Among those who commuted to work, it took them on average 28.1 minutes to get to work.

INCOME: The median income of households in Pepeekeo CDP was \$26,031. Sixty-five percent of the households received earnings and 25 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. Forty-two percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$14,612. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS: In 2005-2009, 32 percent of people were in poverty. Fifty-eight percent of related children under 18 were below the poverty level, compared with 9 percent of people 65 years old and over. Twenty-eight percent of all families and 41 percent of families with a female householder and no husband present had incomes below the poverty level.

Poverty Rates in Pepeekeo CDP, Hawaii in 2005-2009



POPULATION OF Pepeekeo CDP: In 2005-2009, Pepeekeo CDP had a total population of 1,700 - 850 (49 percent) females and 900 (51 percent) males. The median age was 42.9 years. Twenty-two percent of the population was under 18 years and 20 percent was 65 years and older.


The Age Distribution of People in Pepeekeo CDP, Hawaii in 2005-2009

For people reporting one race alone, 14 percent was White; 1 percent was Black or African American; less than 0.5 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 46 percent was Asian; 18 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and less than 0.5 percent was Some other race. Twenty-one percent reported Two or more races. Nine percent of the people in Pepeekeo CDP was Hispanic. Thirteen percent of the people in Pepeekeo CDP was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Pepeekeo CDP had a total of 800 housing units, 12 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 72 percent was in single-unit structures, 28 percent was in multi-unit structures, and less than 0.5 percent was mobile homes. Four percent of the housing units were built since 1990.


OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Pepeekeo CDP had 700 occupied housing units - 440 (63 percent) owner occupied and 260 (37 percent) renter occupied. Eight percent of the households did not have telephone service and 15 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Thirty-seven percent had two vehicles and another 10 percent had three or more.

HOUSING COSTS: The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$1,100, nonmortgaged owners \$248, and renters \$331. Twenty-four percent of owners with mortgages, 10 percent of owners without mortgages, and 49 percent of renters in Pepeekeo CDP spent 30 percent or more of household income on housing.
