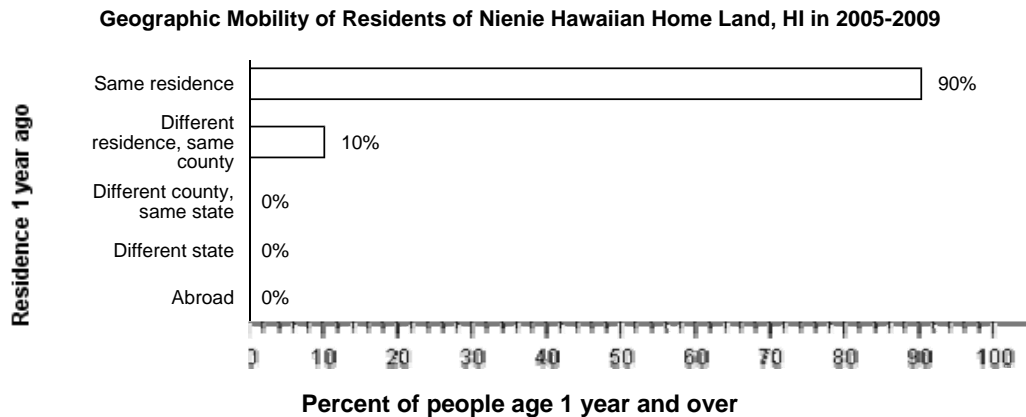

HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES: Data for this section cannot be displayed because the number of sample cases is too small. Displaying the data would risk disclosing information for individuals.

NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE: Nine percent of the people living in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI in 2005-2009 were foreign born. Ninety-one percent was native, including 62 percent who were born in their state of residence.

Among people at least five years old living in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI in 2005-2009, 19 percent spoke a language other than English at home. Of those speaking a language other than English at home, less than 0.5 percent spoke Spanish and 100 percent spoke some other language; 48 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well."

GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY: In 2005-2009, 90 percent of the people at least one year old living in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI were living in the same residence one year earlier; 10 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, less than 0.5 percent from another county in the same state, less than 0.5 percent from another state, and less than 0.5 percent from abroad.



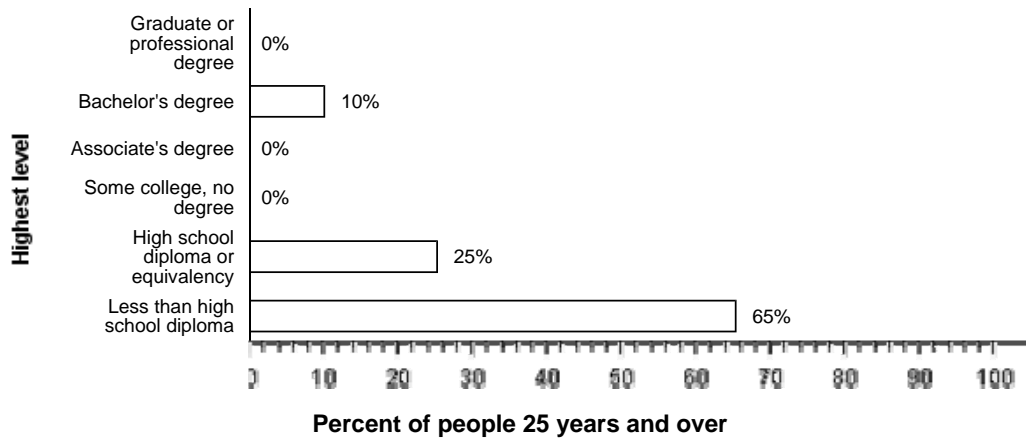

EDUCATION: In 2005-2009, 35 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 10 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Sixty-five percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI was less than 0.5 in 2005-2009. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was less than 0.5 and elementary or high school

enrollment was less than 0.5 children. College or graduate school enrollment was less than 0.5.

The Educational Attainment of People in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI in 2005-2009

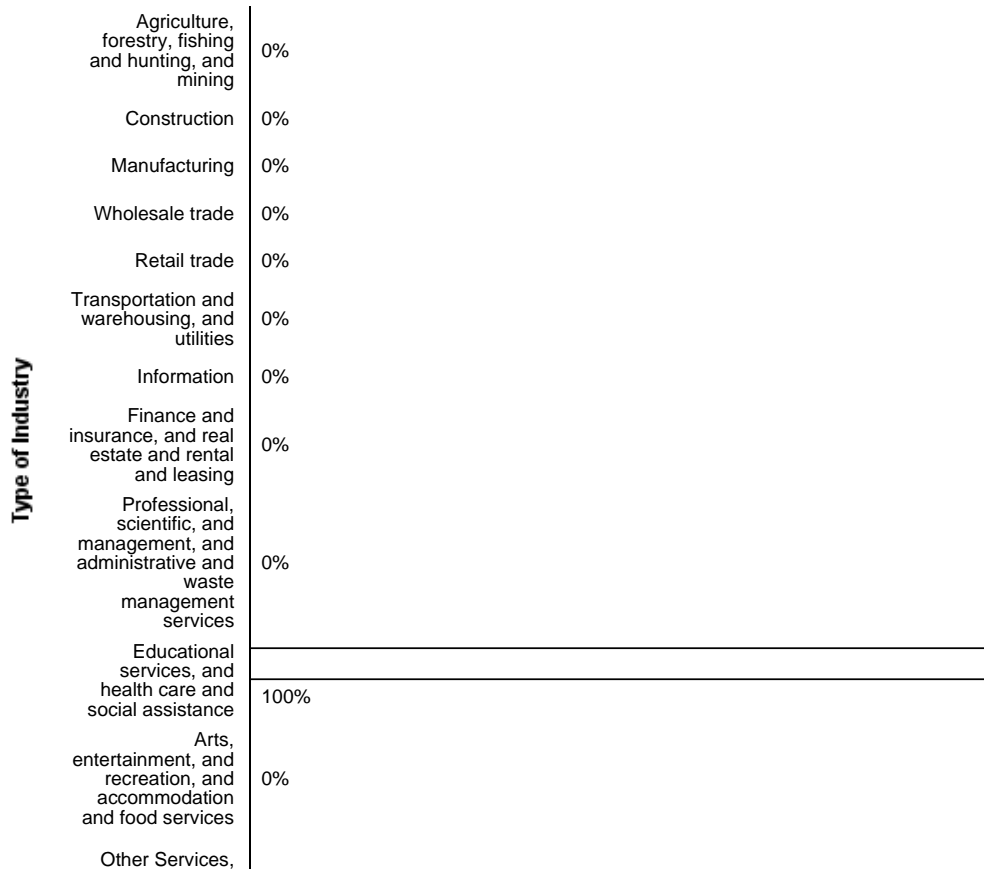


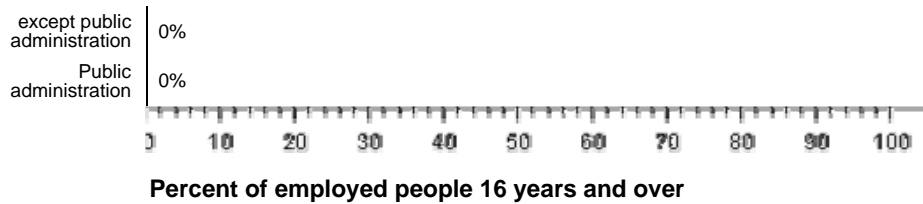

DISABILITY: In Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI, among people at least five years old in 2005-2009, percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to percent of those 65 and older.

INDUSTRIES: In 2005-2009, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI were Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 100 percent, and Agriculture, forestry, fishing and hunting, and mining, less than 0.5 percent.

OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER: Among the most common occupations were: Management, professional, and related occupations, 100 percent; Service occupations, less than 0.5 percent; Sales and office occupations, less than 0.5 percent; Farming, fishing, and forestry occupations, less than 0.5 percent; and Construction, extraction, maintenance, and repair occupations, less than 0.5 percent. One hundred percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; less than 0.5 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and less than 0.5 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

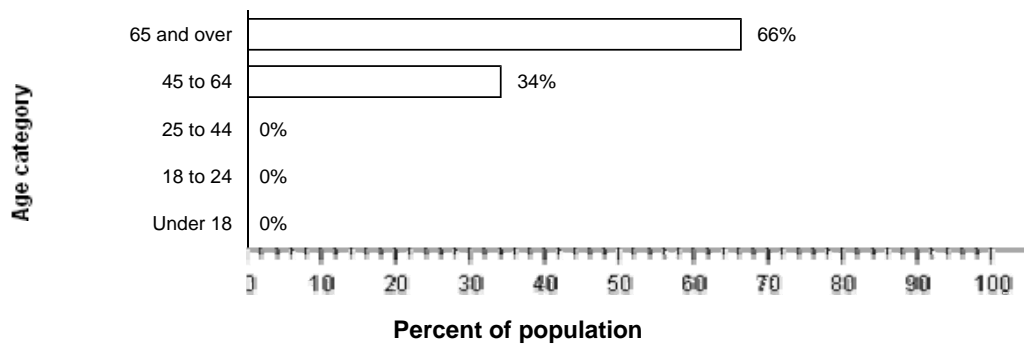

POPULATION OF Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI: In 2005-2009, Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI had a total population of 140 - 66 (49 percent) females and 69 (51 percent) males. The median age was 70.7 years. Less than 0.5 percent of the population was under 18 years and 66 percent was 65 years and older.

The Age Distribution of People in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI in 2005-2009

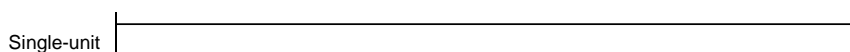


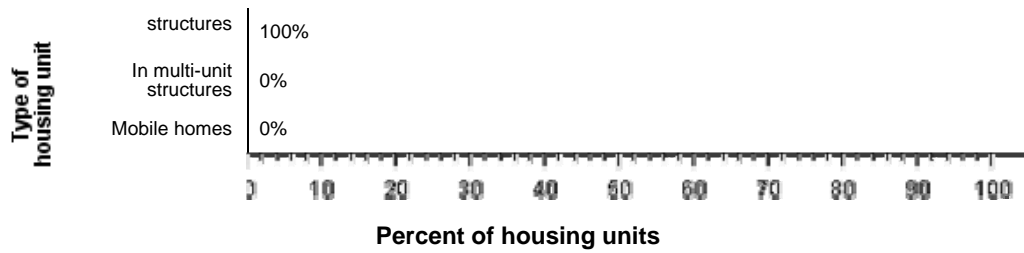

For people reporting one race alone, 29 percent was White; less than 0.5 percent was Black or African American; less than 0.5 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 9 percent was Asian; 24 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and less than 0.5 percent was Some other race. Thirty-eight percent reported Two or more races. Less than 0.5 percent of the people in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI was Hispanic. Twenty-nine percent of the people in Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI had a total of 7 housing units, 43 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 100 percent was in single-unit structures, less than 0.5 percent was in multi-unit structures, and less than 0.5 percent was mobile homes. Less than 0.5 percent of the housing units were built since 1990.

OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS: In 2005-2009, Nienie Hawaiian Home Land, HI had 4 occupied housing units - 4 (100 percent) owner occupied and less than 0.5 (less than 0.5 percent) renter occupied. One hundred percent of the households did not have telephone service and less than 0.5 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Multi Vehicle households were not rare. One hundred percent had two vehicles and another less than 0.5 percent had three or more.
