


In 2010-2014 there were 64,600 households in Hawaii County, Hawaii. The average household size was 2.9 people.



Region of Birth for the Foreign Born Population in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014




Percent of the Population 5 years and over who Speak a Language other than English in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014

Geographic Mobility of Residents of Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format







Percent of Workers 16 and over Commuting by Mode in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format




Median Earnings for Full-Time Year-Round Workers by Sex in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014


Proportion of Households with Various Income Sources in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format


Health Insurance

Age Distribution of People in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format



Types of Housing Units in Hawaii County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format







Housing Costs

The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$1,692, nonmortgaged owners \$329, and renters \$1,039. An estimated 47 percent of owners with mortgages, 12 percent of owners without mortgages, and 58 percent of renters in Hawaii County, Hawaii spent 30 percent or more of household income on housing.





Region of Birth for the Foreign Born Population in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014




Percent of the Population 5 years and over who Speak a Language other than English in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014

Geographic Mobility of Residents of Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format







Percent of Workers 16 and over Commuting by Mode in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format




Median Earnings for Full-Time Year-Round Workers by Sex in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-


Proportion of Households with Various Income Sources in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format



Age Distribution of People in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format



Types of Housing Units in Honolulu County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format











Region of Birth for the Foreign Born Population in Kalawao County, Hawaii in 2010-2014




Percent of the Population 5 years and over who Speak a Language other than English in Kalawao County, Hawaii in 2010-2014







Percent of Workers 16 and over Commuting by Mode in Kalawao County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format




Median Earnings for Full-Time Year-Round Workers by Sex in Kalawao County, Hawaii in 2010-



Age Distribution of People in Kalawao County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format











Percent of the Population 5 years and over who Speak a Language other than English in Kauai County, Hawaii in 2010-2014



Geographic Mobility of Residents of Kauai County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format








Percent of Workers 16 and over Commuting by Mode in Kauai County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format




Proportion of Households with Various Income Sources in Kauai County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format



Age Distribution of People in Kauai County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format













Geographic Mobility of Residents of Maui County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format








Percent of Workers 16 and over Commuting by Mode in Maui County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format




Proportion of Households with Various Income Sources in Maui County, Hawaii in 2010-2014 click graph to view data in table format








