The 2020 Census will shape your future.

Every 10 years, the United States counts everyone living in the country on April 1.

Respond for your family and your community

Information collected from the census helps with distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal funds, grants, and support for states, counties, and communities - like yours.

Local governments rely on census information to plan for community needs like new roads, schools, and emergency services.

Responding is easy

Starting in mid-March your household will receive a notice to complete the 2020 Census. The form asks basic questions and is available in many languages.

Responding is safe and private

It is against the law for the Census Bureau to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or your household. By law, your responses cannot be used .against you
