

# Hawaii Housing Facts for July 1, 2015

The U.S. Census Bureau released its housing unit estimates on May 19, 2016. Below are some statistics on housing units within the State of Hawaii.

On July 1, 2015, Hawaii had 532,455 housing units. This was an increase of 12,947 or a 2.5% increase from April 1, 2010 and 0.5% increase per year. Hawaii ranked 42<sup>nd</sup> in number of housing units among all states within the nation and D.C.

Among our four counties, the City and County of Honolulu had the largest share of housing units with about 65%, followed by Hawaii County with 16%, Maui County with about 14% and lastly Kauai County with about 6%.

The housing units increased by 2.5% in the state between April 1, 2010 and July 1, 2015. The housing unit growth was much higher in Hawaii County than in the other three counties. Housing units in Hawaii County increased by 4.5% while the other three counties had 1.9%-2.4% increases in their housing units for the period.
