

## **Daily Population Changes for the State of Hawaii: 2016 to 2017**

On July 1, 2016, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,428,683.

On July 1, 2017, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,427,538.

On average, between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017, there was a decrease of 3 people per day:

49 births per day

34 deaths per day

19 more people moving out of the State of Hawaii than those moving into the State of Hawaii per day (includes both movement from foreign countries and movement from other states in the U.S.)

18 more people moving into the State of Hawaii from foreign countries than those moving out of the State of Hawaii to foreign countries per day

37 more people moving out of the State of Hawaii to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the State of Hawaii from other states per day

**Daily Population Changes for  
the County of Hawaii: 2016 to 2017**

On July 1, 2016, the resident population for the County of Hawaii was 198,681.

On July 1, 2017, the resident population for the County of Hawaii was 200,381.

On average, between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017, there was an increase of 5 people per day:

6 births per day

5 deaths per day

4 more people moving into the County of Hawaii than those moving out of the County of Hawaii per day (includes both movement from foreign countries and movement from other states in the U.S.)

2 more people moving into the County of Hawaii from foreign countries than those moving out of the County of Hawaii to foreign countries per day

2 more people moving into the County of Hawaii from other states in the U.S. than those moving out of the County of Hawaii to other states per day

## **Daily Population Changes for the City and County of Honolulu: 2016 to 2017**

On July 1, 2016, the resident population for the City and County of Honolulu was 992,761.

On July 1, 2017, the resident population for the City and County of Honolulu was 988,650.

On average, between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017, there was a decrease of 11 people per day:

35 births per day

23 deaths per day

24 more people moving out of the City and County of Honolulu than those moving into the City and County of Honolulu per day (includes both movement from foreign countries and movement from other states in the U.S.)

13 more people moving into the City and County of Honolulu from foreign countries than those moving out of the City and County of Honolulu to foreign countries per day

37 more people moving out of the City and County of Honolulu to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the City and County of Honolulu from other states per day

**Daily Population Changes for  
the County of Kauai: 2016 to 2017**

On July 1, 2016, the resident population for the County of Kauai was 71,769.

On July 1, 2017, the resident population for the County of Kauai was 72,159.

On average, between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017, there was an increase of 1 person per day:

2 births per day

2 deaths per day

1 more person moving into the County of Kauai than those moving out of the County of Kauai per day (includes both movement from foreign countries and movement from other states in the U.S.)

1 more person moving into the County of Kauai from foreign countries than those moving out of the County of Kauai to foreign countries per day

1 more person moving out of the County of Kauai to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the County of Kauai from other states per day

## **Daily Population Changes for the County of Maui: 2016 to 2017**

On July 1, 2016, the resident population for the County of Maui was 165,472.

On July 1, 2017, the resident population for the County of Maui was 166,348.

On average, between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017, there was an increase of 2 people per day:

5 births per day

4 deaths per day

1 more person moving into the County of Maui than those moving out of the County of Maui per day (includes both movement from foreign countries and movement from other states in the U.S.)

2 more people moving into the County of Maui from foreign countries than those moving out of the County of Maui to foreign countries per day

1 more person moving out of the County of Maui from other states in the U.S. than those moving into the County of Maui into other states per day
