LATEST POPULATION ESTIMATE DATA

The **Latest Population Estimates** contain the most up-to-date Hawaii population estimates. Data for July 1st of each year are available for total population; demographic components of change such as births, deaths, net migration; and characteristics such as age, sex, race (5 major race groups) and Hispanic origin. In addition to the above, housing unit data are also released annually. For Hawaii, total population estimates may be obtained for the state, 5 counties, 2 metropolitan areas, 2 micropolitan areas, and for only 1 census designated place (Honolulu CDP).

These data are released by the Population Estimates Program, which is a part of the U.S. Census Bureau. They are considered the official estimates of population and housing between decennial censuses. The estimates are based on the last decennial census figures and updated during the decade using administrative records data.

The latest state and county population counts for the State of Hawaii are the most frequently requested data . A good general way to start your data search is by using the "2014 Population Estimates Summary" table which are linked below. It contains key data for July 1, 2014, the period 2013 to 2014, and the period 2010 to 2014. More information may be found in the sections below the summary data and at [DBEDT Data Warehouse](#).



AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY

The **American Community Survey (ACS)** is an annual survey taken by the U.S. Census Bureau. Data collected includes social, economic, housing and population data. ACS provides data for the nation, states, counties and other geographic areas down to the block group level. Data profiles for selected detailed population groups such as Native Hawaiians and Filipinos are also available for higher level geographies such as the state and sometimes the City and County of Honolulu.

The ACS data are released in three waves each year. The first wave released is called the 1-year dataset and includes geographic areas with populations of 65,000 or more. The second wave is called the 3-year dataset (combining 3 years of survey data) and includes geographic areas with populations of 20,000 or more. The third wave is called the 5-year dataset (combining 5 years of survey data) and includes all geographic areas down to the block group level.

A good way to start your data search is to decide what geographic area you are interested in. Local level data is popular and for most areas below the county level, data users would need to use the 5-year ACS datasets. The next step is to obtain the data that you need. Geographic area profiles contain a wealth of information and will probably serve your needs. In addition to the profiles, other summary and detailed census data are available especially through the [U.S. Census Bureau's American FactFinder](#)

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2009-2013 AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY 5-YEAR DATA FOR HAWAII

The U.S. Census Bureau released its 2009-2013 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year estimates on December 4, 2014. The estimates are based on the annual American Community Survey conducted by the Census Bureau which include social, economic, and detailed housing characteristics of Hawaii's population.

The Census Bureau releases 5-year data for all census geographic areas down to the block group level. About 8.5% of Hawaii's population was surveyed between the 2009 to 2013 period.

Some interesting additions to the 2013 ACS 5-year dataset series are tables for bachelor's field of degree, poverty age breakdown, selected characteristics of the uninsured, and health insurance by age. Through the use of the census tract data, information by islands may also be obtained.

DECENNIAL CENSUS

The **Decennial Census** is conducted every 10 years by the U.S. Census Bureau. It is a count of everyone residing in the United States on the census date of April 1st. The 2010 Census was the last decennial census taken.


In 2010, there were 10 questions on the form which included key demographic information such as gender, age, race, household relationship and whether the housing unit was rented or owned. Detailed socioeconomic data was no longer collected and is now found in the Census Bureau's annual American Community Survey. Data from the 2010 Census is available from the national level down to the block level.

A good way to start your data search for 2010 Census data is to decide what geographic area you are interested in. Local level data (below the county level) are frequently requested and the geographical level of census tract is recommended. Census tracts cover every part of our state. The next step is to obtain the data that you need. The demographic profiles will provide some basic information from this census. A series of Hawaii State Data Center reports found on the "DBEDT Product Page" may also be a good source of 2010 data that you need.


