- U.S. Constitution adopted September 17, 1787
- Requires that a Census of Population be conducted every 10 years (Article 1, Section 2)
- Representatives in Congress to be apportioned among the states, and direct taxes also to be apportioned

# 1790 Census

- Federal marshals conduct first census
- Legal requirements
  - Visit every household
  - Post completed census schedules in “two of the most public places within each jurisdiction”
- Enumeration details
  - Slaves = 3/5 person
  - American Indians excluded
  - Six questions, including name of head of household, count of occupants

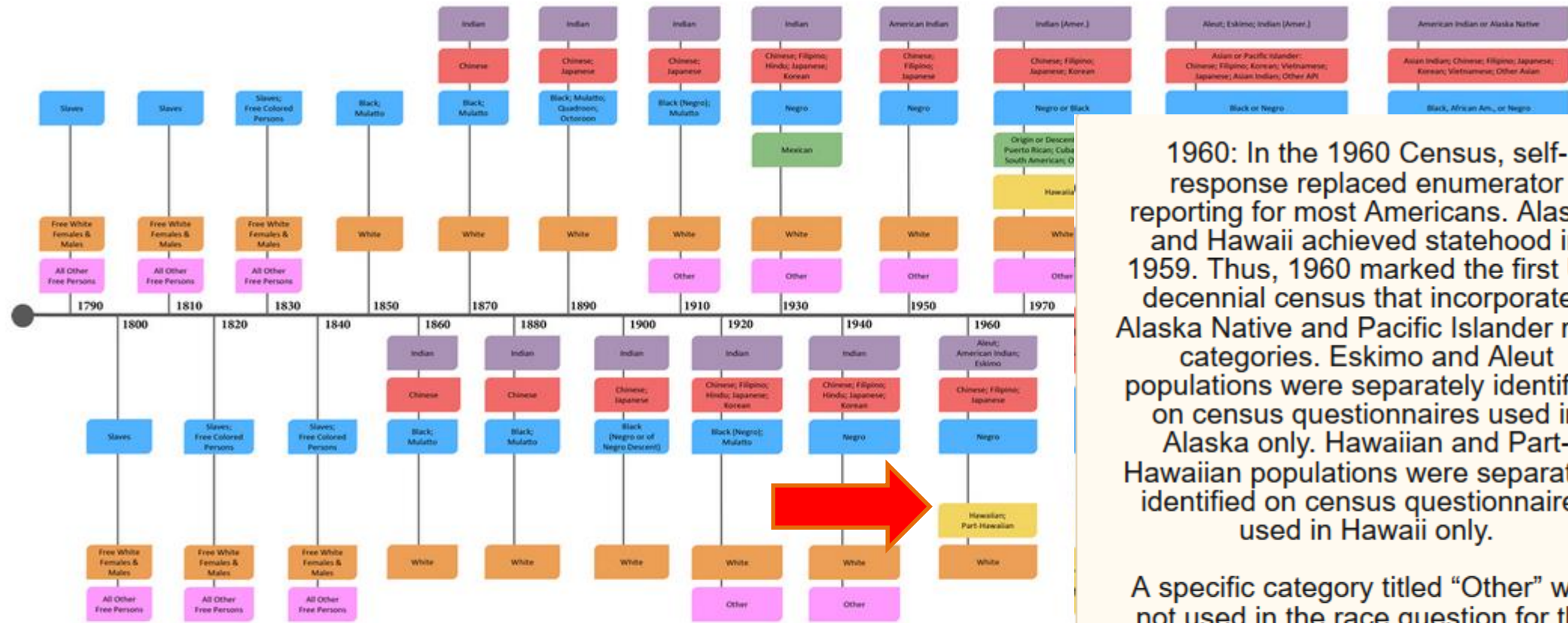

## Measuring Race and Ethnicity Across the Decades: 1790–2010 Mapped to 1997 U.S. Office of Management and Budget Classification Standards



1960: In the 1960 Census, self-response replaced enumerator reporting for most Americans. Alaska and Hawaii achieved statehood in 1959. Thus, 1960 marked the first US decennial census that incorporated Alaska Native and Pacific Islander race categories. Eskimo and Aleut populations were separately identified on census questionnaires used in Alaska only. Hawaiian and Part-Hawaiian populations were separately identified on census questionnaires used in Hawaii only.

A specific category titled "Other" was not used in the race question for the 1960 Census; rather, the list of racial categories for respondents to choose from ended with "etc.?"

# Race and Ethnicity Data

- Guidelines provided by U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB)
  - Social definition of race recognized in U.S.
  - Not biological or anthropological definitions
- Uses of the data
  - Meet legislative redistricting requirements
  - Monitor compliance with Voting Rights Act
  - Assess home mortgage lending patterns of financial institutions to meet credit needs of minorities
  - Assess racial disparities in health

# OMB Ethnicity Standards

- OMB Ethnicity Categories
  - Hispanic or Latino
  - Not Hispanic or Latino
- Race & Ethnicity are considered separate concepts
- Hispanic is an ethnicity, NOT a race. It is asked in a separate question from race. Everyone is asked both the race and the Hispanic origin question
- Based on self-identification
- Those who identify as either ethnicity category above may be of any race(s).

## 2010 Census Ethnicity Question

→ NOTE: Please answer BOTH Question 8 about Hispanic origin and Question 9 about race. For this census, Hispanic origins are not races.

# Race Data Tabulation Concepts

- **Race Alone**
  - Includes people who indicated only one race
  - For example, people who identified as “Asian and no other race” are included in the Asian Alone category
  
- **Two or More Races**
  - Includes people who reported more than one race
  - 57 combinations of the major race groups
  
- **Race Alone or in Combination**
  - Represents the maximum number of people who reported as that race group, either alone or in combination with one or more additional race(s)

# “Race Alone”

- People who reported a single entry (e.g., Korean or Black) and no other race
- People who reported two or more entries within the same major race group (e.g., Asian). For example, respondents who reported Korean and Vietnamese are part of the larger “Asian alone” race group
- Data tables will include “alone” in the name, for example, “White alone” or “Some Other Race alone”
- The race “alone” groups will include Hispanics unless specifically labeled “not Hispanic or Latino”. So “White alone” will include Hispanics who are also White but “White alone, not Hispanic or Latino” will not include White Hispanics

# “Race Alone or in any Combination”

- People who reported a single race alone (e.g., Asian) **AND** people who reported that race in combination with one or more of the other major race groups
- Data tabulations are usually referred to as “tallies”
- Represents the maximum number of people who reported as that race group, either alone or in combination with one or more additional race(s)
- The sum of the six individual race “alone-or-in-combination” categories add to **more than the total population** because people who reported more than one race were tallied in each race category
- Applies to detailed race groups, such as American Indian and Alaska Native tribes and detailed Asian and Pacific Islander groups. For example, Korean alone or in any combination includes people who reported a single response (e.g., Korean), people who reported Korean and another Asian group (e.g., Korean and Vietnamese), and people who reported Korean in combination with one or more other non-Asian race groups

## Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands. It includes people who indicate their race as "Native Hawaiian," "Guamanian or Chamorro," "Samoan," and "Other Pacific Islander" or provide other detailed Pacific Islander responses.

*Native Hawaiian*--Includes people who indicate their race as "Native Hawaiian" or report entries such as Part Hawaiian or Hawaiian.

*Samoan*--Includes people who indicate their race as "Samoan" or report entries such as American Samoan or Western Samoan.

*Tongan*--Includes people who provide a response such as Tongan or Tonga.

*Other Polynesian*--Includes people who provide a response of another Polynesian group, such as Tahitian, Tokelauan, or wrote in a generic term such as "Polynesian."

*Guamanian or Chamorro*--Includes people who indicate their race as "Guamanian or Chamorro" or report entries such as Chamorro or Guam.

*Marshallese*--Includes people who provide a response such as Marshallese or Marshall Islands.

*Other Micronesian*--Includes people who provide a response of another Micronesian group, such as Carolinian, Chuukese, I-Kiribati, Kosraean, Mariana Islander, Palauan, Pohnpeian, Saipanese, Yapese, or wrote in a generic term such as "Micronesian."

*Fijian*--Includes people who provide a response such as Fijian or Fiji.

*Other Melanesian*--Includes people who provide a response of another Melanesian group, such as Guinean, Hebrides Islander, Solomon Islander, or wrote in a generic term such as "Melanesian."

*Other Pacific Islander, not specified*--Includes respondents who checked the Other Pacific Islander response category on the census questionnaire and did not write in a specific group or wrote in a generic term such as "Pacific Islander."

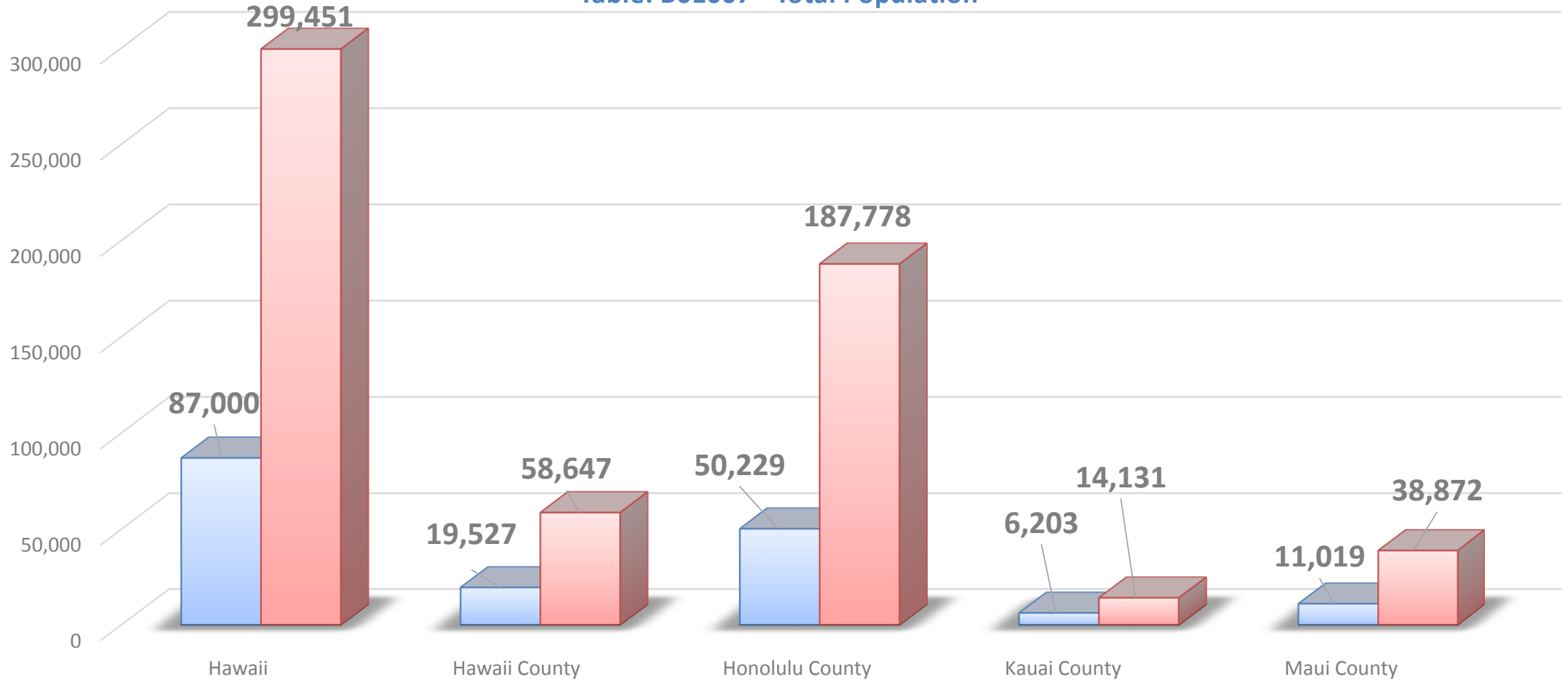

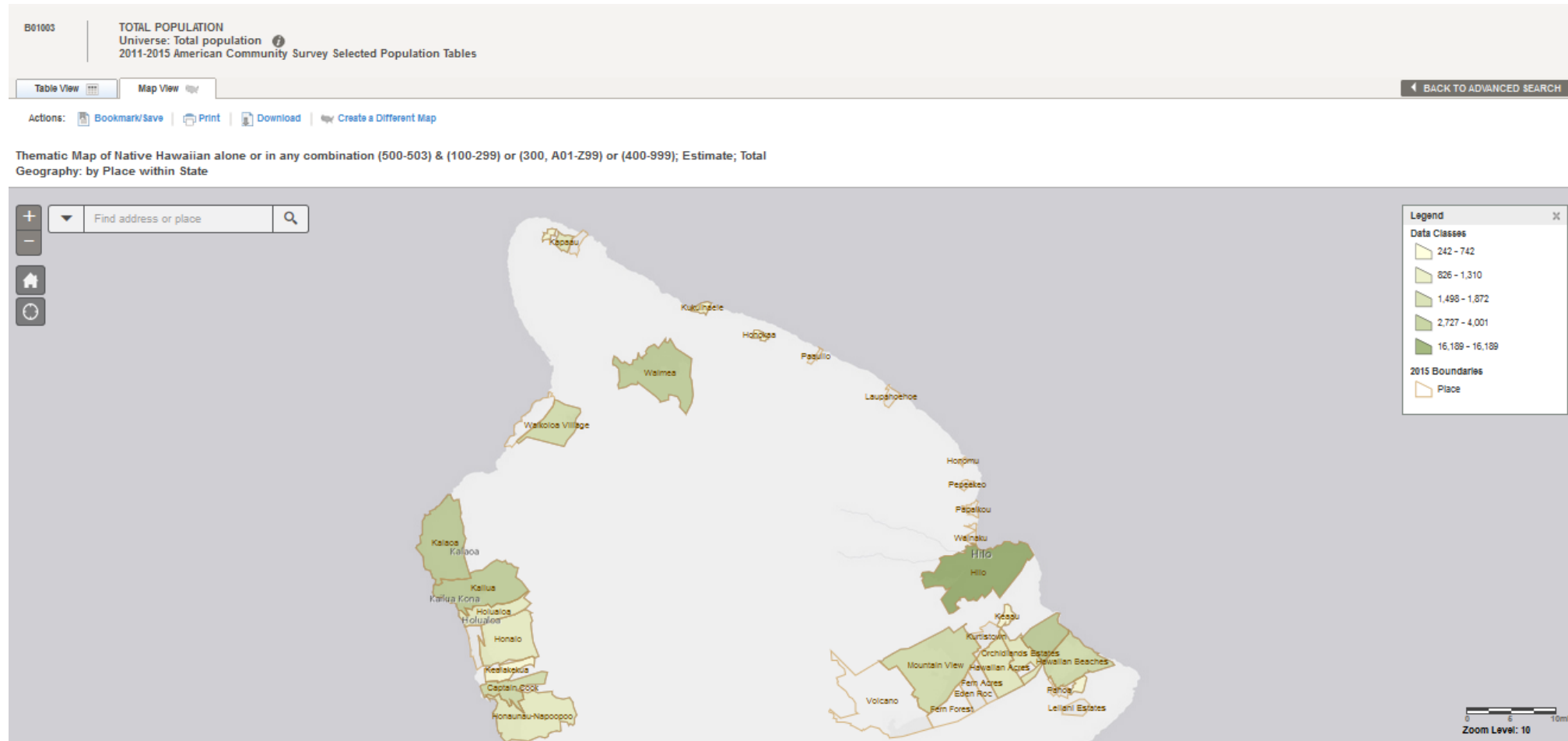

# Ancestry

- Ancestry refers to a person's ethnic origin or decent, "roots," heritage, or the place of birth of the person or the person's parents or ancestors before their arrival in the United States.
- The intent of the ancestry question is not to measure the degree of attachment to a particular ethnicity.
  - For example, a response of "Irish" might reflect total involvement in an "Irish" community or only a memory of ancestors several generations removed from the individual.
- A person's ancestry is not necessarily the same as his/her place of birth.

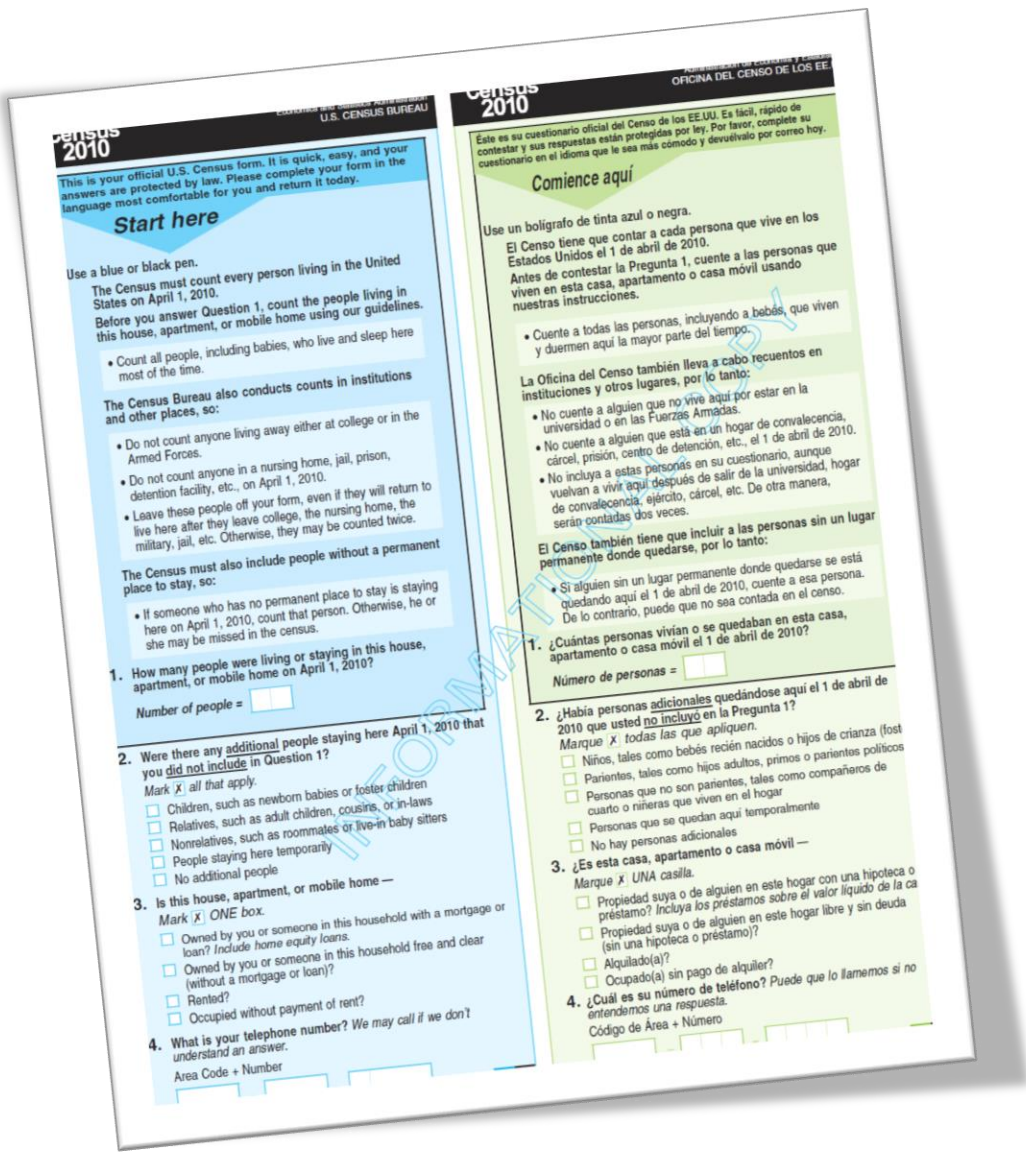

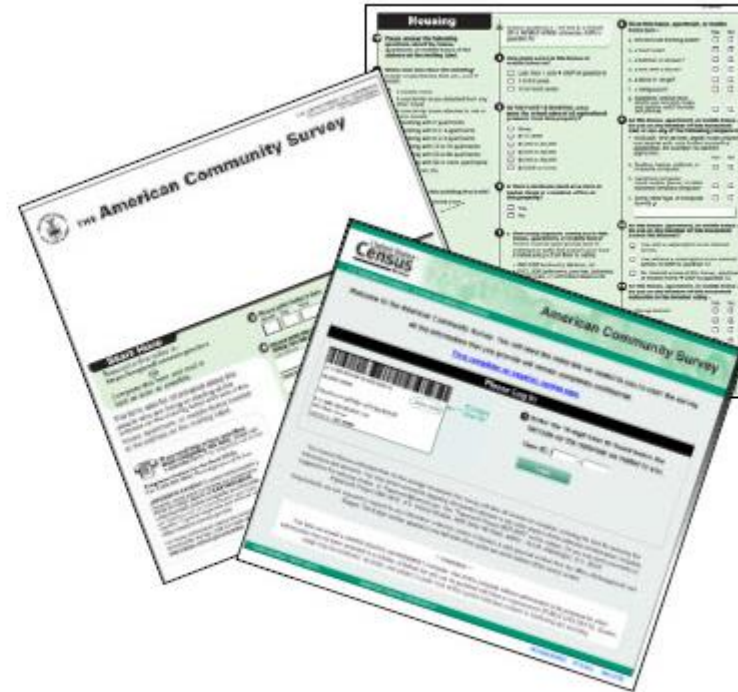

# Survey of Business Owners

---

- Business ownership is defined as having 51 percent or more of the stock or equity in the business
- Does not distinguish between U.S. residents and nonresidents
- Companies owned by foreign governments or owned by other companies, foreign or domestic are included in the category “Publicly held and other firms not classifiable by gender, ethnicity, race, and veteran status”
- Businesses could be tabulated in more than one racial group
  - The sole owner was reported to be of more than one race.
  - The majority owner (or majority combination of owners) reported to be of more than one race.
  - For example, if a firm responded as both Chinese and Black majority owned, the firm would be included in the detailed Asian and Black estimates, but would only be counted once toward the higher level all firms' estimates.
