Executive Summary 4th Quarter 2020

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This *Quarterly Statistical and Economic Report* has been prepared by the staff of the Research and Economic Analysis Division of the State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT). The report provides concise statistical information and analyses on Labor, Income and Prices, Taxes, Tourism, Construction, and other indicators, as well as an overview of the State of Hawaii and the four counties.

Technical notes and source descriptions have been kept to a minimum. However, the staff of the Research and Economic Analysis Division would be happy to respond to any inquiries of a technical nature that readers may have (586-2466). The quarterly information contained in this report reflects data received by the Research Division on or before November 30, 2020.

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STATE OF THE ECONOMY

Hawaii's major economic indicators were mainly negative in the third quarter of 2020. Visitor arrivals, wage and salary jobs, and State general fund tax revenues all decreased in the quarter compared to the third quarter of 2019. Only government contracts awarded, and private building authorizations increased in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, the total number of visitors arriving by air to Hawaii decreased 2,575,894 or 97.6 percent. Due to longer lengths of stay, the daily visitor census decreased 91.8 percent in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, jobs in the construction sector increased 0.5 percent or 200 jobs compared with the same quarter of 2019. The government contracts awarded increased from \$165.6 million in the third quarter of 2019 to \$266.5 million in the third quarter of 2020. In the third quarter of 2020, the permit value for private construction increased \$44.5 million or 5.6 percent compared with the same quarter of 2019. According to the most recent excise tax base data available, current construction put-in-place decreased \$186.6 million or 7.7 percent in the second quarter of 2020, compared with the same quarter of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, State general fund tax revenues were down \$59.0 million or 3.2 percent over the same period of 2019. The net individual income tax revenues increased \$256.7 million or 38.9 percent, the state general excise tax revenue decreased \$227.1 million or 24.6 percent, and the transient accommodations tax (TAT) decreased \$163.3 million or 92.1 percent. In the first three quarters of 2020, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$680.7 million or 12.1 percent, and state general excise tax revenue decreased \$393.2 million or 14.4 percent, compared to the same period of the previous year.

Labor market conditions were all negative. In the third quarter of 2020, Hawaii's non-agricultural wage and salary jobs averaged 537,700 jobs, a decrease of 111,000 jobs or 17.1 percent from the same quarter of 2019.

In this quarter, the private sector lost about 107,700 non-agricultural jobs compared to the third quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 33,300 jobs or 77.8 percent; followed by Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 30,000 jobs or 42.7 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities, which lost 9,800 jobs or 28.7 percent, Professional & Business Services, lost 7,500 jobs

or 10.1 percent, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, lost 5,900 jobs or 43.1 percent, and Retail Trade, lost 5,300 jobs or 7.5 percent in the quarter. For the private sector, in the third quarter of 2020, only Natural Resources, Mining & Construction, added 200 jobs or 0.5 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 3,300 jobs or 2.7 percent in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. The Federal Government added 500 jobs or 1.5 percent, the State Government lost 3,300 jobs or 4.9 percent, and the Local Government lost 500 jobs or 2.6 percent, compared to the third quarter of 2019.

In the second quarter of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$11,682 million or 12.3 percent, from the second quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$5,579 million or 5.9 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the second quarter of 2020, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2012 dollars) decreased \$11,456 million or 13.9 percent from the second quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, total annualized real GDP decreased \$6,359 million or 7.7 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2020, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings decreased \$5,041.2 million or 12.5 percent from the second quarter of 2019. In dollar terms, the largest decrease occurred in accommodation and food services; followed by arts, entertainment, and recreation, transportation and warehousing, retail trade, and other services. During the second quarter of 2020, total government earnings decreased \$277.8 million or 1.7 percent from the same quarter of 2019. Earnings from the federal government increased \$230.5 million or 2.5 percent. Earnings from the state and local governments decreased \$508.2 million or 6.9 percent in the quarter.

In the first half of 2020, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 1.6 percent from the same period in 2019. This is 0.4 of a percentage point above the 1.2 percent increase for the U.S. average CPI-U; however, it is lower than the first half of 2019 Honolulu CPI-U increase of 2.0 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the first half of 2020, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Apparel (4.9 percent), followed by Food and Beverages (2.7 percent) and Recreation (2.7 percent), Housing (2.6 percent), and Education and Communication (0.9 percent). The price of Transportation decreased 4.5 percent and the price of Other Goods and Services decreased 1.4 percent compared to the first half of 2019.

OUTLOOK FOR THE ECONOMY

Hawaii's economy has been greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. During the April-September 2020 period, the average unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 17.1 percent. Hawaii lost 114,700 non-agriculture payroll jobs during the April-September period as compared with the same period a year ago. All industry sectors lost jobs except construction and federal government jobs. The accommodation and food services & drinking places accounted for 54.4 percent of the total job loss at 62,350. Overall, statewide non-agriculture payroll jobs decreased by 17.1 percent in the third quarter of 2020.

Hawaii's unemployment rate increased from 2.6 percent in the first quarter of 2020 to 20.3 percent in the second quarter of 2020, and then decreased to 13.9 percent in the third quarter of 2020.

Visitor arrivals to the State during the third quarter of 2020 totaled 63,775, a decrease of 97.6 percent from the same quarter in 2019. However, due to longer average length of stay, the average daily visitor census decreased only 91.8 percent in the third quarter of 2020.

The value of private building permits showed an increase of 5.6 percent during the third quarter of 2020. The largest increase occurred in the commercial & industrial category which was up by 44.4 percent. The value of residential building permits was up by 11.3 percent, and the value for additions & alterations category declined by 5.8 percent during the same period. In the third quarter of 2020, the state government spending on capital investment projects (CIP) declined by 39.2 percent or \$168.1 million, however, government contracts awarded increased 61.0 percent or \$101.0 million during the same time period.

At the national level, the U.S. economic growth rate was at 0.3 percent during the first quarter, reduced to negative 9.0 percent in the second quarter, and improved to negative 2.9 percent as compared to the same quarter in 2019. The Blue Chip Economic Indicators report from November 10, 2020, which is the consensus of 50 economic forecasting organizations, projected that the U.S. economic growth rate for 2020 will decrease by 3.7 percent. The report

projected a positive 4.0 percent U.S. economic growth for 2021. The Blue Chip forecasts for foreign countries were all negative in 2020 except China which showed small growth. Based on the above developments, DBEDT projects that Hawaii's economic growth rate, as measured by the real gross domestic product (GDP), will decline by 11.2 percent in 2020, then will increase at 2.1 percent in 2021, 2.0 percent in 2022, and 1.2 percent in 2023.

Hawaii will welcome 2.7 million visitors in 2020, a decrease of 73.7 percent from the 2019 level. Visitor arrivals will increase to 6.2 million in 2021, 7.7 million in 2022, and 8.8 million in 2023. Visitor spending will decrease 71.4 percent in 2020, then will increase 105.6 percent in 2021, 27.2 percent in 2022, and 14.1 percent in 2023.

Non-agriculture payroll jobs will shrink by 11.9 percent in 2020, then will increase by 6.1 percent in 2021, 2.5 percent in 2022, and 1.9 percent in 2023.

Overall for 2020, the average annual unemployment rate will be at 11.2 percent, then decrease to 7.9 percent in 2021, 7.1 percent in 2022, and 6.6 percent in 2023. These rates are much higher than Hawaii's average unemployment rate of 2.5 percent from 2017 to 2019.

Nominal personal income is expected to increase by 7.6 percent in 2020, mainly due to the federal assistance programs. The majority of the increase in personal income came from government transfers related to unemployment insurance payments and other transfers mostly related to the CARES ACT funds, which offset declines in wages and salaries. Nominal personal income is expected to decrease by 7.8 percent in 2021 due to the reduction in federal assistance programs.

Hawaii's consumer inflation rate, as measured by the Honolulu Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, will increase at rates between 1.6 and 2.3 for the next few years.

Hawaii's population is expected to decrease 0.1 percent in 2020, and increase by 0.1 percent in 2021, and 0.3 percent in 2022 and 2023.

COUNTY ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

Overall economic conditions were mostly negative across the counties in the third quarter of 2020. The unemployment rate increased in all counties while total non-agricultural wage and salary jobs and total visitor arrivals by air declined. The value of private building permits increased in Honolulu and Kauai but decreased in all other counties.

In the third quarter of 2020, the unemployment rate in Honolulu increased 9.4 percentage points from 2.6 percent to 12.0 percent; the unemployment rate in Maui County increased 19.6 percentage points from 2.6 percent to 22.2 percent; the unemployment rate in Hawaii County increased 9.5 percentage points from 3.5 percent to 13.0 percent; and the unemployment rate in Kauai County increased 16.7 percentage points from 2.6 percent to 19.3 percent.

In the third quarter of 2020, Honolulu lost 69,100 non-agricultural wage and salary jobs compared to the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 22,000 jobs or 45.5 percent. This was followed by Accommodation which lost 14,400 jobs or 75.0 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 6,800 jobs or 27.8 percent, Professional & Business Services which lost 5,400 jobs or 9.5 percent, and Arts, Entertainment & Recreation which lost 3,500 jobs or 41.2 percent in the quarter. For the private sector, in the third quarter of 2020, only Natural Resources, Mining & Construction, added 700 jobs or 2.6 percent. The Government sector lost 3,000 jobs or 3.2 percent in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, Hawaii County lost 10,900 or 15.6 percent of non-agricultural wage and salary jobs over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 4,000 jobs or 69.0 percent. This was followed by Food Services and Drinking Places which lost 1,500 jobs or 21.7 percent, Retail Trade which lost 1,300 jobs or 13.4 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 1,200 jobs or 35.3 percent, and Professional & Business Services which lost 800 jobs or 12.1

percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 400 jobs or 2.8 percent in the quarter.

Maui County lost 22,900 jobs or a 28.7 percent decrease in the third quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation which lost 10,700 jobs or 82.3 percent. This was followed by Food Services and Drinking Places which lost 5,100 jobs or 49.0 percent, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation which lost 1,900 jobs or 82.6 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 1,400 jobs or 30.4 percent, and Professional & Business Services which lost 900 jobs or 12.3 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 200 jobs or 2.3 percent in the quarter.

Kauai County lost 8,500 jobs or a 25.5 percent decrease in the third quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation which lost 4,300 jobs or 89.6 percent. Food Services and Drinking Places lost 1,400 jobs or 29.8 percent, Retail Trade lost 700 jobs or 17.1 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 700 jobs or 41.2 percent, and Professional & Business Services which lost 600 jobs or 18.8 percent in the quarter. Government sector jobs was unchanged in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, visitor arrivals by air decreased in all counties. Visitor arrivals by air decreased 97.3 percent in Honolulu, 99.0 percent in Maui, 97.6 percent in Hawaii County, and 98.9 percent in Kauai compared to the same quarter of 2019.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building permits increased in Honolulu and Kauai, but decreased in all other counties. In the third quarter of 2020, private building permits increased \$120.5 million or 26.4 percent in Honolulu, increased \$31.1 million or 104.1 percent in Kauai (only residential available), decreased \$41.9 million or 23.9 percent in Hawaii County, and decreased \$65.3 million or 47.9 percent in Maui from the same quarter of the previous year.

Hawaii's labor market conditions were all negative in the third quarter of 2020. The civilian labor force and the civilian employment both decreased. Since the civilian unemployment decreased more than the civilian labor force, the civilian unemployment rate decreased in the quarter. The civilian non-agricultural wage and salary jobs also decreased.

In the third quarter of 2020, the civilian labor force averaged 630,300 people, a decrease of 34,200 people or 5.1 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-1). In the first three quarters of 2020, the civilian labor force declined by 20,900 people or 3.1 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Civilian employment totaled 543,050 people in the third quarter of 2020, a decrease of 103,100 people or 16.0 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-2). In the first three quarters of 2020, average civilian employment decreased 80,000 people or 12.4 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, the number of civilian unemployed averaged 87,250, an increase of 68,900 people or 375.5 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-3). In the first three quarters of 2020, the number of unemployed increased 59,100 people or 319.7 percent from the same period of the previous year.

The unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 13.9 percent in the third quarter of 2020, 11.1 percentage points above the third quarter of 2019 (Table A-4). In the first three quarters of 2020, the unemployment rate increased 9.5 percentage points from the same period of the previous year to 12.3 percent.

In the third quarter of 2020, Hawaii's non-agricultural wage and salary jobs averaged 537,700 jobs, a decrease of 111,000 jobs or 17.1 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-6). In the first three quarters of 2020, average non-agricultural wage and salary jobs decreased 11.7 percent or 76,500 jobs from the same period of the previous year.

The job decrease in the third quarter of 2020 was due to job decreases in both the private sector and the government sector. In this quarter, the private sector lost about 107,700 non-agricultural jobs compared to the third quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 33,300 jobs or 77.8 percent (Table A-18); followed by Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 30,000 jobs or 42.7 percent (Table A-19), Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities, which lost 9,800 jobs or 28.7 percent (Table A-11), Professional & Business Services, lost 7,500 jobs or 10.1 percent (Table A-14), Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, lost 5,900 jobs or 43.1 percent (Table A-17), and Retail Trade, lost 5,300 jobs or 7.5 percent (Table A-10) in the quarter.

For the private sector, in the third quarter of 2020, only Natural Resources, Mining & Construction, added 200 jobs or 0.5 percent (Table A-7) in the quarter.

The Government sector lost 3,300 jobs or 2.7 percent (Table A-21) in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. The Federal Government added 500 jobs or 1.5 percent (Table A-22), the State Government lost 3,300 jobs or 4.9 percent (Table A-23), and the Local Government lost 500 jobs or 2.6 percent (Table A-24), compared to the third quarter of 2019.

B. INCOME AND PRICES

In the second quarter of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$11,682 million or 12.3 percent, from the second quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$5,579 million or 5.9 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the second quarter of 2020, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2012 dollars) decreased \$11,456 million or 13.9 percent from the second quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, total annualized real GDP decreased \$6,359 million or 7.7 percent from the same period of the previous year (Tables B-1 to B-3).

Hawaii's total personal income increased during the second quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019 due to increased personal current transfer receipts.

In the second quarter of 2020, total nominal annualized personal income (i.e. not adjusted for inflation) increased \$12,750.9 million or 15.9 percent over that of 2019 (Table B-5). In the first half of 2020, total annualized personal income was \$87,496.2 million, an increase of 9.1 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2020, wages and salaries decreased \$3,802.4 million or 9.7 percent over that of 2019. In the first half of 2020, wages and salaries decreased 3.9 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-8).

Supplements to wages and salaries, consisting of employer payments to retirement plans, private group health insurance plans, private workers compensation plans, and other such benefits, decreased \$708.4 million or 6.4 percent in the second quarter of 2020 from the same quarter of 2019 (Table B-9). In the first half of 2020, supplements to wages and salaries decreased 3.1 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Proprietors' income decreased \$746.0 million or 11.2 percent in the second quarter of 2020 over that of 2019 (Table B-10). In the first half of 2020, proprietors' income was down 3.8 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Dividends, interest, and rent decreased \$132.1 million or 0.8 percent in the second quarter of 2020 from the same quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, income in this category was up 0.5 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-11).

The annualized personal current transfer receipts grew by \$17,708.5 million or 140.2 percent in the second quarter of 2020 from the same quarter of 2019 (Table B-12). In the first half of 2020, personal current transfer receipts increased 73.0 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Contributions to government social insurance, which is subtracted from total personal income, decreased \$431.5 million or 6.6 percent in the second quarter of 2020 compared to the second quarter of 2019. In the first half of 2020, contributions to government social insurance decreased 2.3 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-13).

In the second quarter of 2020, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings decreased \$5,041.2 million or 12.5 percent from the second quarter of 2019. In dollar the decrease occurred terms, largest in accommodation and food services; followed by arts, entertainment, and recreation, transportation and warehousing, retail trade, and other services. During the second quarter of 2020, total government earnings decreased \$277.8 million or 1.7 percent from the same quarter of 2019. Earnings from the federal government increased \$230.5 million or 2.5 percent. Earnings from the state and local governments decreased \$508.2 million or 6.9 percent in the quarter (Table B-4).

In the first half of 2020, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 1.6 percent from the same period in 2019 (Table B-14). This is 0.4 of a percentage point above the 1.2 percent increase for the U.S. average CPI-U but is lower than the first half of 2019 Honolulu CPI-U increase of 2.0 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the first half of 2020, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Apparel (4.9 percent), followed by Food and Beverages (2.7 percent) and Recreation (2.7 percent), Housing (2.6)percent), and Education and Communication (0.9 percent). The price of Transportation decreased 4.5 percent and the price of Other Goods and Services decreased 1.4 percent compared to the first half of 2019.

C. TAX REVENUES

The State general fund tax revenues decreased in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. Among the components shown, the GET decreased the most; followed by the Transient Accommodations Tax (TAT). Net Individual Income Tax and Net Corporate Income Tax revenues both increased in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, total tax collections distributed to the State general fund totaled \$1,793.4 million, a decrease of \$59.0 million or 3.2 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Tables C-1 and C-2). In the first three quarters of 2020, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$680.7 million or 12.1 percent over the same period of the previous year.

During the third quarter of 2020, GET revenues (excluding the Honolulu County Surcharge) totaled \$696.0 million, a decrease of \$227.1 million or 24.6 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Table C-3). In the first three quarters of 2020, GET revenues decreased \$393.2 million or 14.4 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Compared to the third quarter of 2019, Net Individual Income Tax revenues increased \$256.7 million or 38.9 percent to \$915.9 million in the third quarter of 2020 (Table C-4). In the third quarter of 2020, Declaration of Estimated Taxes increased \$190.6 million or 111.6 percent (Table C-5), Payments with Returns increased

\$111.5 million or 449.5 percent (Table C-6), Revenues from Withholding Tax on Wages decreased \$6.4 million or 1.2 percent (Table C-7), and Refunds increased \$39.1 million or 60.3 percent (Table C-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, Net Individual Income Tax collections decreased \$67.1 million or 3.2 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Net Corporate Income Tax revenues, which tend to be volatile by nature, increased from \$26.2 million in the third quarter of 2019 to \$43.7 million in the third quarter of 2020 (Table In the third quarter of 2020, the Declaration of Estimated Taxes increased \$11.3 million or 22.5 percent (Table C-10), the Payment with Returns increased \$8.7 million or 526.0 percent (Table C-11), and the Refunds increased \$2.5 million or 9.8 percent (Table C-12), compared with the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, Net Corporate Income Tax revenues decreased \$111.2 million from \$123.9 million in the first three quarters of 2019 to \$12.7 million in the first three quarters of 2020.

In the third quarter of 2020, Transient Accommodations Tax (TAT) revenues decreased \$163.3 million or 92.1 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table C-13). In the first three quarters of 2020, TAT revenues decreased \$236.4 million or 47.8 percent from the same period of the previous year.

D. TOURISM

Due to the impact of COVID-19, domestic visitor arrivals and international visitor arrivals both decreased in the third quarter of 2020. Due to longer lengths of stay, the daily visitor census decreased less than the decrease of visitor arrivals in the quarter.

The total number of visitor arrivals by air decreased 2,575,894 or 97.6 percent in the third quarter of 2020, compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Tables D-1 and D-2). The total average daily census was down 227,665 or 91.8 percent in the quarter. In the first three quarters of 2020, total visitor arrivals by air decreased 5,543,598 or 71.7 percent, while the average daily census decreased 167,243 or 67.4 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, total visitor arrivals on domestic flights decreased 1,827,057 or 96.8 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-3). In the first three quarters of 2020, domestic arrivals were down 3,911,747 or 71.3 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Arrivals on international flights decreased 748,837 or 99.6 percent in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the third quarter of 2019 (Table D-4). In the first three quarters of 2020, international arrivals decreased 1,631,850 or 72.6 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In terms of major market areas, from the third quarter of 2019 to the same period of 2020, arrivals from the U.S. West decreased 1,153,573 or 97.0 percent (Table D-5), arrivals from the U.S. East decreased 555,386 or 96.4 percent (Table D-6), and arrivals from Japan decreased 438,890 or 99.9 percent (Table D-7). In the first three quarters of 2020, arrivals from the U.S. West were down 2,483,995 or 72.1 percent; arrivals from the U.S. East were down 1,217,966 or 69.1 percent; and Japanese arrivals were down 878,830 or 74.9 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, the length of stay per visitor increased. Due to the longer length of stay, the average total daily visitor census decreased less than

the decrease in visitor arrivals in the quarter. The total average daily visitor census was down 91.8 percent or 227,665 visitors per day in the third quarter of 2020, over the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-8). The domestic average daily census decreased 89.4 percent or 165,070 visitors per day (Table D-9), while the international average daily census decreased 99.1 percent or 62,595 visitors per day (Table D-10). In the first three quarters of 2020, the domestic average daily census decreased 121,608 or 66.1 percent; and the international average daily census declined 45,634 or 70.9 percent from the same period of the previous year.

According to the most recent data available, nominal visitor expenditures by air totaled \$3,879.4 million in the first quarter of 2020, down 13.4 percent or \$601.6 million from the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-11). In 2019, visitor expenditures increased \$193.3 million or 1.1 percent from the previous year.

Total airline capacity, as measured by the number of available seats flown to Hawaii, decreased 85.7 percent or 2,982,054 seats (Table D-12) in the third quarter of 2020, domestic seats decreased 82.1 percent or 2,105,259 seats (Table D-13); international seats declined 95.8 percent or 876,795 seats (Table D-14), compared to the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, the number of total available seats decreased 60.4 percent or 6,175,123 seats from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 20.7 percent, 62.1 percentage points lower than the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-15). In the first three quarters of 2020, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 42.5 percent, 38.8 percentage points lower than the same period of the previous year.



E. CONSTRUCTION

The indicators of Hawaii's construction industry were mostly positive in the third quarter of 2020. Private building authorizations, government contracts awarded, and construction jobs increased, but state government CIP expenditures decreased in the quarter.

In the third quarter of 2020, the number of jobs in the construction sector increased 0.5 percent or 200 jobs compared with the same quarter of 2019. Construction was the only private sector that added jobs in the third quarter of 2020 compared with the same quarter of In the first three quarters of 2020, the construction sector added 400 jobs or 1.2 percent (Table A-7) from the same period of the previous year. Before the recession, specifically the period of 2002 through 2007, construction job growth averaged 8.0 percent per year. In the fourth quarter of 2007, the average number of construction jobs reached a peak of 40,550 jobs, and then declined as the economy entered a recession. From the second quarter of 2008 until the second quarter of 2011 quarter-over-quarter construction job growth was negative in all quarters.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in the state increased \$44.5 million or 5.6 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, private building authorizations in the state decreased \$47.6 million or 2.0 percent compared with the same period in 2019.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Honolulu increased \$120.5 million or 26.4 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, private building authorizations in Honolulu decreased \$134.1 million or 8.9 percent, compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Hawaii County decreased \$41.9 million or 23.9 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, private building authorizations in Hawaii County increased \$44.0 million or 10.4 percent, compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Maui decreased \$65.3 million or 47.9 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, private building authorizations in Maui increased \$0.3 million or 0.1 percent compared with the same period in 2019.

In the third quarter of 2020, private building authorizations (residential only) in Kauai County increased \$31.1 million or 104.1 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In the first three quarters of 2020, private building authorizations in Kauai County increased \$42.1 million or 46.4 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

Government contracts awarded increased \$101.0 million, from \$165.6 million in the third quarter of 2019 to \$266.5 million in the third quarter of 2020. (Table E-1). In the first three quarters of 2020, government contracts awarded increased \$1,740.6 million, from \$450.6 million to \$2,191.2 million. In January 2020, the U.S. Navy awarded a 5-year contract of a \$990 million awarded to 7 firms, 5 of which were Hawaii firms. No per-firm awards were specified. State government CIP expenditures decreased \$168.1 million or 39.2 percent in the third quarter of 2020 compared with the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, state government CIP expenditures decreased \$99.5 million or 8.7 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table E-2).

The Honolulu Construction Cost Index increased 0.8 percent in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019 for Single Family Residence (Table E-6) and showed no change for High-Rise Building (Table E-7). In the first three quarters of 2020, the index for Single Family Residence increased 2.4 percent and 1.5 percent for High-Rise Building as compared to the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, Honolulu's median price for single family resales was \$840,000, up \$40,000 or 5.0 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Table E-11). The median price for condominium units was \$440,000, same as the same quarter of 2019 (Table E-12). In the third quarter of 2020, the number of single-family unit resales increased 4.0 percent, and the number of condominium unit resales decreased 13.4 percent, compared with the third quarter of 2019 (Tables E-13 and E-14). In the first three quarters of 2020, the number of single-family unit resales decreased 1.4 percent, and condominium unit resales declined 18.9 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the first three quarters of 2020, Maui County's single-family unit resales median price was \$775,000 and the condominium unit resales median price was \$560,000 (Tables E-17 and E-18).

F. OTHER INDICATORS

The total number of bankruptcy filings in Hawaii declined 8.2 percent or by 35 cases for the third quarter of 2020, from the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, total filings declined 7.4 percent or 95 cases from the same period of the previous year.

The number of Chapter 7 filings, the largest category, declined 2.0 percent or 6 cases in the third quarter of 2020. Chapter 7 filings are intended to liquidate assets and discharge debt. In the first three quarters of 2020, Chapter 7 filings increased 0.6 percent or 5 cases from the same period of the previous year.

Chapter 11 filings declined from 3 to 1 case in the third quarter of 2020 compared with the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, Chapter 11 filings declined to 6 cases from

7 cases in the same period of the previous year. Chapter 11 filings involve the structuring of repayment plans for companies.

Chapter 13 filings declined 21.7 percent or 28 cases in the third quarter of 2020, from the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, Chapter 13 filings declined 25.2 percent or 101 cases from the same period of the previous year. Chapter 13 bankruptcy allows debtors to work out repayment arrangements with creditors.
