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# STATE OF THE ECONOMY

Hawaii's major economic indicators were mainly negative in the fourth quarter of 2020. Visitor arrivals, wage and salary jobs, State general fund tax revenues, and private building authorizations all decreased in the quarter compared to the fourth quarter of 2019. Only government contracts awarded increased in the quarter.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the total number of visitors arriving by air to Hawaii decreased 2,013,165 or 80.2 percent. Due to longer lengths of stay, the daily visitor census decreased 70.7 percent in the quarter.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, jobs in the construction sector decreased 1.9 percent or 700 jobs compared with the same quarter of 2019. The government contracts awarded increased \$746.4 million from \$143.2 million in the fourth quarter of 2019 to \$889.5 million in the fourth quarter of 2020. In the fourth quarter of 2020, the permit value for private construction decreased \$65.4 million or 7.7 percent compared with the same quarter of 2019. According to the most recent excise tax base data available, current construction put-in-place increased \$202.7 million or 8.3 percent in the third quarter of 2020, compared with the same quarter of the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, State general fund tax revenues were down \$196.2 million or 11.7 percent over the same period of 2019. The net individual income tax revenues decreased \$19.1 million or 3.1 percent, the state general excise tax revenue decreased \$170.3 million or 19.7 percent, and the transient accommodations tax (TAT) decreased \$119.0 million or 83.5 percent. In 2020, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$877.0 million or 12.0 percent, and state general excise tax revenue decreased \$593.4 million or 15.6 percent, compared to the previous year.

Labor market conditions were all negative. In the fourth quarter of 2020, Hawaii's non-agricultural wage and salary jobs averaged 561,500 jobs, a decrease of 101,400 jobs or 15.3 percent from the same quarter of 2019.

In this quarter, the private sector lost about 92,400 non-agricultural jobs compared to the fourth quarter of 2019. All private sector industries lost jobs in the quarter. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 26,300 jobs or 61.9 percent; followed by Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 23,900 jobs or 33.9 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities, which lost 8,800 jobs or 25.3 percent, Professional & Business Services, lost 8,500 jobs or 11.3 percent, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, lost 3,700 jobs or 27.4

percent, Retail Trade, lost 3,200 jobs or 4.5 percent, and Other Services, lost 3,200 jobs or 11.3 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 9,000 jobs or 7.0 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. The Federal Government lost 600 jobs or 1.7 percent, the State Government lost 8,600 jobs or 11.4 percent, and the Local Government added 100 jobs or 0.5 percent, compared to the fourth quarter of 2019.

In the third quarter of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$6,160 million or 6.4 percent, from the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$5,772 million or 6.1 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the third quarter of 2020, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2012 dollars) decreased \$6,784 million or 8.2 percent from the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, total annualized real GDP decreased \$6,500 million or 7.9 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings decreased \$3,879.7 million or 9.5 percent from the third quarter of 2019. In dollar terms, the largest decrease occurred in accommodation and food services; followed by other services. arts, entertainment, and recreation, transportation and warehousing, and retail trade. During the third quarter of 2020, total government earnings increased \$162.7 million or 1.0 percent from the same quarter of 2019. Earnings from the federal government increased \$187.0 million or 2.0 percent. Earnings from the state and local governments decreased \$24.3 million or 0.3 percent in the quarter.

In the second half of 2020, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 1.6 percent from the same period in 2019. This is 0.4 of a percentage point above the U.S. average CPI-U and is higher than the second half of 2019 Honolulu CPI-U increase of 1.3 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the second half of 2020, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Food and Beverages (6.9 percent), followed by Recreation (4.5 percent), Education and Communication (4.2 percent), and Housing (1.4 percent). The price of Apparel decreased 7.1 percent; the price of Transportation decreased 5.2 percent, and the price of Other Goods and Services decreased 0.8 percent compared to the second half of 2019.

## **OUTLOOK FOR THE ECONOMY**

Hawaii's economy has been greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. During the April-December 2020 period, the average unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 15.1 percent. Hawaii lost 110,600 non-agriculture payroll jobs during the April-December period as compared with the same period a year ago. All industry sectors lost jobs except for federal government jobs. The accommodation and food services & drinking places accounted for 52.6 percent of the total job loss at 58,200. Overall, statewide non-agriculture payroll jobs decreased by 16.9 percent in the April-December 2020 period.

Hawaii's unemployment rate increased from 2.6 percent in the first quarter of 2020 to 20.3 percent in the second quarter of 2020, decreased to 13.9 percent in the third quarter of 2020, and then decreased further to 11.2 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020..

Visitor arrivals to the State during the fourth quarter of 2020 totaled 496,186, a decrease of 80.2 percent from the same quarter in 2019. However, due to the longer average length of stay, the average daily visitor census decreased only 70.7 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020.

The value of private building permits showed a decrease of 7.7 percent or \$65.4 million during the fourth quarter of 2020. The largest decrease occurred in the commercial & industrial category which was down by \$55.6 million or 37.1 percent. The value of residential building permits was down by 0.9 percent, and the value for additions & alterations category declined by 1.8 percent during the same period. In the fourth quarter of 2020, the state government spending on capital investment projects (CIP) increased by 100.2 percent or \$298.2 million, and government contracts awarded in the fourth quarter of 2020 increased \$746.4 million over the fourth quarter of 2019.

At the national level, the U.S. economic growth rate was at 0.3 percent during the first quarter, fell to a negative 9.0 percent in the second quarter, improved to negative 2.8 percent in the third quarter, and improved further to negative 2.5 percent in the fourth quarter as compared to the same quarter in 2019. The

Blue Chip Economic Indicators report from February 12, 2020, which is the consensus of 50 economic forecasting organizations, projected that the U.S. economic growth rate for 2021 will increase by 4.9 percent. The report projected a positive 3.8 percent U.S. economic growth for 2022. The Blue Chip forecasts for foreign countries were all positive in 2021. Based on the above developments, DBEDT projects that Hawaii's economic growth rate, as measured by the real gross domestic product (GDP), will increase by 2.7 percent in 2021, then will increase by 3.3 percent in 2022, 2.3 percent in 2023, and 1.8 percent in 2024.

Hawaii will welcome 5.5 million visitors in 2021, an increase of 102.9 percent from the 2020 level. Visitor arrivals will increase to 8.3 million in 2022, 9.2 million in 2023, and 9.8 million in 2024. Visitor spending will increase 90.9 percent in 2021, then will increase 48.6 percent in 2022, 12.7 percent in 2023, and 11.1 percent in 2024.

Non-agriculture payroll jobs will increase 6.2 percent in 2021, then will increase by 3.1 percent in 2022, 1.6 percent in 2023, and 1.3 percent in 2024.

Overall for 2021, the average annual unemployment rate is forecast to be 8.2 percent, then decrease to 6.9 percent in 2022, 6.2 percent in 2023, and 5.7 percent in 2024. These rates are much higher than Hawaii's average unemployment rate of 2.5 percent from 2017 to 2019.

Nominal personal income is expected to decrease by 2.9 percent in 2021, then increase 1.8 percent in 2022, increase 3.1 percent in 2023, and increase 3.3 percent in 2024.

Hawaii's consumer inflation rate, as measured by the Honolulu Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, will increase at about 2.0 percent per year for the next few years.

Hawaii's population is expected to decrease 0.1 percent in 2021, and increase by 0.1 percent in 2022, and 0.2 percent in 2023 and 2024.

## COUNTY ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

Overall economic conditions were mostly negative across the counties in the fourth quarter of 2020. The unemployment rate increased in all counties compared with the same quarter of 2019, while total non-agricultural wage and salary jobs and total visitor arrivals by air declined. The value of private building permits increased in Hawaii County but decreased in all other counties.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the unemployment rate in Honolulu increased 7.4 percentage points from 2.4 percent to 9.8 percent compared with the same quarter of 2019; the unemployment rate in Maui County increased 14.7 percentage points from 2.5 percent to 17.2 percent; the unemployment rate in Hawaii County increased 7.6 percentage points from 3.2 percent to 10.8 percent; and the unemployment rate in Kauai County increased 12.6 percentage points from 2.6 percent to 15.2 percent.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, Honolulu lost 63,800 non-agricultural wage and salary jobs compared to the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 17,100 jobs or 35.0 percent. This was followed by Accommodation which lost 10,500 jobs or 55.3 percent, Professional & Business Services which lost 6,500 jobs or 11.2 percent, and Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 6,000 jobs or 24.0 percent in the quarter. For the private sector, only Natural Resources, Mining & Construction did not lose jobs in the quarter. The Government sector lost 7,400 jobs or 7.4 percent in the quarter.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, Hawaii County lost 10,300 or 14.4 percent of non-agricultural wage and salary jobs over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 3,600 jobs or 61.0 percent. This was followed by Food Services and Drinking Places which lost 1,100 jobs or 15.9 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 1,100 jobs or 32.4 percent, Professional & Business Services which lost 900 jobs or 13.2 percent, and Retail Trade which lost 800 jobs or

8.2 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 1,100 jobs or 7.1 percent in the quarter.

Maui County lost 19,900 jobs or a 24.8 percent decrease in the fourth quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation which lost 8,800 jobs or 68.8 percent. This was followed by Food Services and Drinking Places which lost 4,400 jobs or 43.1 percent, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation which lost 1,600 jobs or 72.7 percent, Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 1,400 jobs or 29.2 percent, and Professional & Business Services which lost 900 jobs or 12.3 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 400 jobs or 4.3 percent in the quarter.

Kauai County lost 7,500 jobs or a 22.5 percent decrease in the fourth quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation which lost 3,500 jobs or 72.9 percent. This was followed by Food Services and Drinking Places which lost 1,200 jobs or 26.7 percent, Retail Trade which lost 600 jobs or 15.0 percent, and Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities which lost 500 jobs or 31.3 percent in the quarter. The Government sector lost 200 jobs or 3.8 percent in the quarter.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, visitor arrivals by air decreased in all counties. Visitor arrivals by air decreased 84.9 percent in Honolulu, 76.2 percent in Maui, 80.3 percent in Hawaii County, and 86.9 percent in Kauai compared to the same quarter of 2019.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building permits increased in Hawaii County, but decreased in all other counties. In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building permits decreased \$112.6 million or 20.2 percent in Honolulu, decreased \$15.9 million or 49.0 percent in Kauai (only residential available), decreased \$11.7 million or 8.8 percent in Maui, but increased \$74.8 million or 57.4 percent in Hawaii County from the same quarter of the previous year.

## A. LABOR FORCE AND JOBS

Hawaii's labor market conditions were all negative in the fourth quarter of 2020. The civilian unemployment rate increased due to the number of unemployed civilians increasing, combined with the size of the labor force decreasing. The civilian non-agricultural wage and salary jobs also decreased.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the civilian labor force averaged 651,350 people, a decrease of 14,950 people or 2.2 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-1). In 2020, the civilian labor force declined by 19,450 people or 2.9 percent from the previous year.

Civilian employment totaled 578,700 people in the fourth quarter of 2020, a decrease of 71,000 people or 10.9 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-2). In 2020, average civilian employment decreased 77,650 people or 12.0 percent from the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the number of civilian unemployed averaged 72,650, an increase of 56,000 people or 336.3 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-3). In 2020, the number of unemployed increased 58,300 people or 322.7 percent from the previous year.

The unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 11.2 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020, 8.7 percentage points above the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table A-4). In 2020, the unemployment rate increased 9.3 percentage points from the previous year to 12.0 percent.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, Hawaii's non-agricultural wage and salary jobs averaged 561,500 jobs, a decrease of 101,400 jobs or 15.3 percent from the same quarter of 2019 (Table A-6). In 2020, average non-agricultural wage and salary jobs decreased 12.7 percent or 83,000 jobs from the previous year.

The job decrease in the fourth quarter of 2020 was due to job decreases in both the private sector and the government sector. In this quarter, the private sector lost about 92,400 non-agricultural jobs compared to the fourth quarter of 2019. All private sector industries lost jobs in the quarter. Jobs decreased the most in Accommodation, which lost 26,300 jobs or 61.9 percent (Table A-18); followed by Food Services and Drinking Places, which lost 23,900 jobs or 33.9 percent (Table A-19), Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities, which lost 8,800 jobs or 20.7 percent (Table A-11), Professional & Business Services, lost 8,500 jobs or 11.3 percent (Table A-14), Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, lost 3,700 jobs or 27.4 percent (Table A-17), Retail Trade, lost 3,200 jobs or 4.5 percent (Table A-10), and Other Services, lost 3,200 jobs or 11.3 percent (Table A-20) in the quarter.

The Government sector lost 9,000 jobs or 7.0 percent (Table A-21) in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. The Federal Government lost 600 jobs or 1.7 percent (Table A-22), the State Government lost 8,600 jobs or 11.4 percent (Table A-23), and the Local Government added 100 jobs or 0.5 percent (Table A-24), compared to the fourth quarter of 2019.

# **B. INCOME AND PRICES**

In the third quarter of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$6,160 million or 6.4 percent, from the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, total annualized nominal GDP decreased \$5,772 million or 6.1 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the third quarter of 2020, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2012 dollars) decreased \$6,784 million or 8.2 percent from the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, total annualized real GDP decreased \$6,500 million or 7.9 percent from the same period of the previous year (Tables B-1 to B-3).

Hawaii's total personal income increased during the third quarter of 2020 over the same quarter of 2019 mainly due to increased personal current transfer receipts.

In the third quarter of 2020, total nominal annualized personal income (i.e. not adjusted for inflation) increased \$6,612.2 million or 8.2 percent over that of 2019 (Table B-5). In the first three quarters of 2020, total annualized personal income was \$87,053.2 million, an increase of 8.2 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the third quarter of 2020, wages and salaries decreased \$3,300.7 million or 8.3 percent over that of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, wages and salaries decreased 6.0 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-8).

Supplements to wages and salaries, consisting of employer payments to retirement plans, private group health insurance plans, private workers compensation plans, and other such benefits, decreased \$625.0 million or 5.6 percent in the third quarter of 2020 from the same quarter of 2019 (Table B-9). In the first three quarters of 2020, supplements to wages and salaries decreased 4.7 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Proprietors' income increased \$292.1 million or 4.3 percent in the third quarter of 2020 over that of 2019 (Table B-10). In the first three quarters of 2020, proprietors' income was down 0.8 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Dividends, interest, and rent decreased \$230.3 million or 1.3 percent in the third quarter of 2020 from

the same quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, income in this category was down 0.1 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-11).

The annualized personal current transfer receipts grew by \$10,029.4 million or 78.6 percent in the third quarter of 2020 from the same quarter of 2019 (Table B-12). In the first three quarters of 2020, personal current transfer receipts increased 73.5 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Contributions to government social insurance, which is subtracted from total personal income, decreased \$446.8 million or 6.8 percent in the third quarter of 2020 compared to the third quarter of 2019. In the first three quarters of 2020, contributions to government social insurance decreased 4.5 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table B-13).

In the third quarter of 2020, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings decreased \$3,879.7 million or 9.5 percent from the third quarter of 2019. In dollar terms. the largest decrease occurred in accommodation and food services; followed by other arts. entertainment, and recreation, services. transportation and warehousing, and retail trade. During the third quarter of 2020, total government earnings increased \$162.7 million or 1.0 percent from the same quarter of 2019. Earnings from the federal government increased \$187.0 million or 2.0 percent. Earnings from the state and local governments decreased \$24.3 million or 0.3 percent in the quarter (Table B-4).

In the second half of 2020, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 1.6 percent from the same period in 2019 (Table B-14). This is 0.4 of a percentage point above the 1.2 percent increase for the U.S. average CPI-U and is higher than the second half of 2019 Honolulu CPI-U increase of 1.3 percent from the same period of the previous year. In the second half of 2020, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Food and Beverages (6.9 percent), followed (4.5)percent). Education Recreation and Communication (4.2 percent), and Housing (1.4 percent). The price of Apparel decreased 7.1 percent; the price of Transportation decreased 5.2 percent, and the price of Other Goods and Services decreased 0.8 percent compared to the second half of 2019.

#### C. TAX REVENUES

The State general fund tax revenues decreased in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019. The General Excise Tax and Transient Accommodations Tax (TAT) declined while the Net Individual Income Tax and Net Corporate Income Tax revenues increased in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, total tax collections distributed to the State general fund totaled \$1,478.9 million, a decrease of \$196.2 million or 11.7 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Tables C-1 and C-2). In 2020, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$877.0 million or 12.0 percent over the previous year.

During the fourth quarter of 2020, GET revenues (excluding the Honolulu County Surcharge) totaled \$694.1 million, a decrease of \$170.3 million or 19.7 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Table C-3). In 2020, GET revenues decreased \$563.4 million or 15.6 percent from the previous year.

Compared to the fourth quarter of 2019, Net Individual Income Tax revenues decreased \$19.1 million or 3.1 percent to \$593.3 million in the fourth quarter of 2020 (Table C-4). In the fourth quarter of 2020, Declaration of Estimated Taxes increased \$22.5 million or 33.5 percent

(Table C-5), Payments with Returns decreased \$0.9 million or 1.8 percent (Table C-6), Revenues from Withholding Tax on Wages decreased \$28.1 million or 5.1 percent (Table C-7), and Refunds increased \$12.6 million or 22.1 percent (Table C-8). In 2020, Net Individual Income Tax collections decreased \$86.2 million or 3.2 percent from the previous year.

Net Corporate Income Tax revenues, which tend to be volatile by nature, increased from \$13.3 million in the fourth quarter of 2019 to \$28.6 million in the fourth quarter of 2020 (Table C-9). In the fourth quarter of 2020, the Declaration of Estimated Taxes increased \$3.9 million or 7.5 percent (Table C-10), the Payment with Returns increased \$4.0 million (Table C-11), and the Refunds decreased \$7.5 million or 20.0 percent (Table C-12), compared with the same quarter of 2019. In 2020, Net Corporate Income Tax revenues decreased \$95.9 million or 69.9 percent from the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, Transient Accommodations Tax (TAT) revenues decreased \$119.0 million or 83.5 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table C-13). In 2020, TAT revenues decreased \$355.4 million or 55.8 percent from the previous year.

# **D. TOURISM**

Due to the impact of COVID-19, domestic visitor arrivals and international visitor arrivals both decreased in the fourth quarter of 2020. The daily visitor census decreased less than the decrease of visitor arrivals in the quarter.

The total number of visitor arrivals by air decreased 2,013,165 or 80.2 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020, compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Tables D-1 and D-2). The total average daily census was down 169,083 or 70.7 percent in the quarter. In 2020, total visitor arrivals by air decreased 7,556,762 or 73.8 percent, and average daily census decreased 167,699 or 68.2 percent.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, total visitor arrivals on domestic flights decreased 1,279,417 or 72.4 percent compared to the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-3). In 2020, domestic arrivals were down 5,191,164 or 71.6 percent from the previous year.

Arrivals on international flights decreased 733,748 or 99.0 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table D-4). In 2020, international arrivals decreased 2,365,598 or 79.1 percent from 2019.

In terms of major market areas, from the fourth quarter of 2019 to the same period of 2020, arrivals from the U.S. West decreased 804,935 or 70.1 percent (Table D-5), arrivals from the U.S. East decreased 382,494 or 74.4 percent (Table D-6), and arrivals from Japan decreased 400,133 or 99.4 percent (Table D-7). In 2020, arrivals from the U.S. West were down 3,288,931 or 71.6 percent; arrivals from the U.S. East were down 1,600,460 or 70.3 percent; and Japanese arrivals were down 1,278,962 or 81.1 percent from the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the length of stay per visitor increased. Due to the longer length of stay, the average total daily visitor census decreased less than the decrease in visitor arrivals in the quarter. The total average daily visitor census was down 70.7 percent or 169,083 visitors per day in the fourth quarter of 2020, over the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-8). The domestic average daily census decreased 61.5 percent or 109,576 visitors per day (Table D-9), while the international average daily census decreased 97.8 percent or 59,508 visitors per day (Table D-10). In 2020, the domestic average daily census decreased 118,580 or 65.1 percent; and the international average daily census declined 49,119 or 77.4 percent from the previous year.

According to the most recent data available, nominal visitor expenditures by air totaled \$3,879.4 million in the first quarter of 2020, down 13.4 percent or \$601.6 million from the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-11). In 2019, visitor expenditures increased \$193.3 million or 1.1 percent from the previous year.

Total airline capacity, as measured by the number of available seats flown to Hawaii, decreased 62.7 percent or 2,125,559 seats (Table D-12) in the fourth quarter of 2020, domestic seats decreased 51.0 percent or 1,246,020 seats (Table D-13); international seats declined 92.8 percent or 879,539 seats (Table D-14), compared to the same quarter of 2019. In 2020, the number of total available seats decreased 60.6 percent or 8,194,218 seats from the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 21.9 percent, 57.7 percentage points lower than the same quarter of 2019 (Table D-15). In 2020, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 37.1 percent, 43.7 percentage points lower than the previous year.



## E. CONSTRUCTION

The indicators of Hawaii's construction industry were mixed in the fourth quarter of 2020. Private building authorizations and construction jobs decreased, however, government contracts awarded and state government CIP expenditures increased in the quarter.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, the number of jobs in the construction sector decreased 1.9 percent or 700 jobs compared with the same quarter of 2019. In 2020, the construction sector added 100 jobs or 0.3 percent (Table A-7) from the previous year. Before the previous recession, specifically the period of 2002 through 2007, construction job growth averaged 8.0 percent per year. In the fourth quarter of 2007, the average number of construction jobs reached a peak of 40,550 jobs, and then declined as the economy entered a recession. From the second quarter of 2008 until the second quarter of 2011 quarter-over-quarter construction job growth was negative in all quarters.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in the state decreased \$65.4 million or 7.7 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In 2020, private building authorizations in the state decreased \$113.0 million or 3.5 percent compared with the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Honolulu decreased \$112.6 million or 20.2 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In 2020, private building authorizations in Honolulu decreased \$246.6 million or 12.0 percent, compared with the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Hawaii County increased \$74.8 million or 57.4 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In 2020, private building authorizations in Hawaii County increased \$118.8 million or 21.5 percent, compared with the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building authorizations in Maui decreased \$11.7 million or 8.8 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In 2020, private building authorizations in Maui decreased \$11.4 million or 2.4 percent compared with the previous year.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, private building authorizations (residential only) in Kauai County decreased \$15.9 million or 49.0 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Table E-8). In 2020, private building authorizations in Kauai County increased \$26.2 million or 21.3 percent compared with 2019.

Government contracts awarded increased \$746.4 million or 521.3 percent, from \$143.2 million in the fourth quarter of 2019 to \$889.5 million in the fourth quarter of 2020 (Table E-1). In 2020, government contracts awarded increased \$208.1 million or 13.2 percent, from \$1,572.0 million in 2019 to \$1,780.1 million in 2020. In January 2020, the U.S. Navy awarded a 5-year contract of a \$990 million awarded to 7 firms, 5 of which were Hawaii firms. No per-firm State government CIP awards were specified. expenditures increased \$298.2 million or 100.2 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared with the same In 2020, state government CIP quarter of 2019. expenditures increased \$22.9 million or 1.6 percent from the previous year (Table E-2).

The Honolulu Construction Cost Index increased 2.7 percent in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared to the same quarter of 2019 for Single Family Residence (Table E-6) and 2.2 percent for High-Rise Building (Table E-7). Comparing 2019 to 2020, the index for Single Family Residence increased 2.5 percent and 1.7 percent for High-Rise Building.

In the fourth quarter of 2020, Honolulu's median price for single family resales was \$870,000, up \$70,000 or 8.7 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Table E-11). The median price for condominium units was \$440,000, up \$12,000 or 2.8 percent over the same quarter of 2019 (Table E-12). In the fourth quarter of 2020, the number of single-family unit resales increased 13.0 percent, and the number of condominium unit resales increased 5.0 percent, compared with the fourth quarter of 2019 (Tables E-13 and E-14). In 2020, the number of single-family unit resales increased 2.3 percent, and condominium unit resales declined 13.0 percent compared with the previous year.

In 2020, Maui County's single-family unit resales median price was \$795,575 and condominium unit resales median price was \$570,000 (Tables E-17 and E-18).

# F. OTHER INDICATORS

The total number of bankruptcy filings in Hawaii declined 10.1 percent or by 43 cases for the fourth quarter of 2020, from the same quarter of 2019. In 2020, total filings declined 8.1 percent or 138 cases from the previous year.

The number of Chapter 7 filings, the largest category, increased 5.5 percent or 16 cases in the fourth quarter of 2020. Chapter 7 filings are intended to liquidate assets and discharge debt. In 2020, Chapter 7 filings increased 1.8 percent or 21 cases from the previous year.

Chapter 11 filings declined from 6 to 1 case in the fourth quarter of 2020 compared with the fourth quarter of 2019. In 2020, Chapter 11 filings declined to 7 cases from 13 cases in the

previous year. Chapter 11 filings involve the structuring of repayment plans for companies.

Chapter 13 filings declined 41.4 percent or 53 cases in the fourth quarter of 2020, from the same quarter of 2019. In 2020, Chapter 13 filings declined 29.1 percent or 154 cases from the same period of the previous year. Chapter 13 bankruptcy allows debtors to work out repayment arrangements with creditors.
