Revised statistics of per capita GDP by state for 2001-2009 were not released because intercensal state population estimates consistent with the 2000 and 2010 decennial census counts are not currently available.

2/ Real GDP is an inflation-adjusted measure of each State's gross product that is based on national prices for the goods and services produced within that State.

3/ As of July 1 for all years except 2010 which is the April 1, 2010 census count. The resident population for April 1, 1980 was 964,691, April 1, 1990 was 1,108,229 and April 1, 2000 was 1,211,537.

4/ There is a discontinuity in the GDP time series at 1997, where the data change from Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) industry definitions to North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) industry definitions. This discontinuity results from many sources, including differences in source data and different estimation methodologies. This data discontinuity may affect both the levels and the growth rates of the GDP estimates. Users of the GDP estimates are strongly cautioned against appending the two data series in an attempt to construct a single time series of GDP estimates for 1963 to 2010.
