April 10, 2013

Mr. Mission DOCARE calls 8:37am and asks if I have pictures of the coral reef and mooring in Kaumakani and I said yes..i will send again...he and warren will be diving at 1 o'clock today-kwwc asking for evaluation report---

meeting with DAR thursday at 9 at his farm(aurora and myself at heacock farms because he's off from work 3 days)- never has time at his office, always ask if I can go to his farm for meeting—feels very uncomfortable but we need to get this done after over a decade of stalling and conflicts of interest



April 9, (count 7 boards) Visitor Stand up boards and one man canoes in salt pond bay and going through fishermen lines and divers, Kite surfing (4), Wind surfing (5), going on reefs, using county park and state parking and soliciting rides and classes (commercial operators and clubs coming from southshore into west salt pond)- Over capacity and injuring fishing practices and habitat.



hiding and using the bathroom in the bushes at puolo point, Kaua'i camper rentals frequents and solicits Puolo point for night camping grounds, shoreline activities, traversing , taking shells, coral and rocks and walking on reefs—commercial in non-designated area-LICENSE PLATE #KRCR2- company has 5 reported KCR vehicles in the area. Website marketing.

April 6, 2013 -No designation- Surfers,kite, boats, rafts, paddle board, wind surf over fishing grounds and reefs and salt pond bay displaces fishermen, practitioners, gatherers and injures to coral reef and habitat.





April 6, 2013



Commercial operators racing each other and speeding thru puolo to Kaumakani, over fishing grounds, in salt pond bay going over local divers on reef shelf-damages to reef and fishing reported by native divers for years now! This day witnessed 6 vehicles (cat, boat and rafts!) Most recorded 9 in one bay!



8am- teachers (17 taking up 10 car spaces on sand!) research RCUH –canesa (schools from Hanalei, kapaa, kauai, waimea intermediate, kcc, kanuikapono- all foreign teachers with 2 local westside teachers)



escorted by Konohiki Holi and Maka'i Libre- cultural protocol. Most foreign teachers and principle agent do not adhere to cultural protocol and instructions and pepe'e and waiwaiole food gardens were injured, one teacher tried to take drupe and cowry shells, one teach took some coral on the reef and broke it on shore...One teacher is banned from entering sacred areas..fishermen (10) were displaced from their activities---deeming inappropriate areas for research and entry.






Saturday Call Valerie Freitas and she said she was off work..there was nobody else to report complaint; calls from over 30 fishermen have witnessed and complained to DOBOR and KWWC on over 8 vehicles and over 100 people in water in small bay without permit or management.

9:46AM (4-5 OPERATORS)NO DESIGNATION OR PERMISSION-HUGGIE POINT –racing, speeding, over –capacity,GOES OVER NATIVE HAWAIIAN DIVERS and fishermen AND OVER REEFS AND NATIVE HAWAIIAN FISHERIES AND NURSERIES-ILLEGAL MOORING EVIDENCE CORAL BLEACHING AND CAUING CULTURAL CONFLICTS, injuring coral and fisheries with mooring, displacing native practices, unmanaged tourists, feeding fish with foreign matter, introducing outside species, poaching, attaching mooring to coral and fish homes, AND POLLUTION







April 5, 2013 friday

Double checked with Mission and will call Borden for appointment. Borden never replied but call Valerie- Kupuna advisory states that harbor agent Freitas may be informing her commercial boater friends (Holoholo, Bubbles Below, Andy, Fathom five,....)...requesting a list of all commercial operators and recreational users for port allen, small boat harbor, Kekaha, Robinson, and Kukuiula facilities.

April 4, 2013

Joe kamai- kaumakani –rafts left tours on reef---witnessed, catamaran in bay again.

Nolan reports 9:30am “No commercial in county park”-s- they tried camping at puolo point left and went county side They are:Kauai camper rental.com license plate kkr1,2,3 KCMPR123-blue camper and unmarked commercial white van they claim they have friends at airport and they said they can go there! Called DOBOR and no answer...so we called DOCARE and Mr. Mission will send an officer.

DOCARE- Officer Taveres called at 12:05 and cited there is no rules in regards to walking on the reef and coming from the ocean and conducting tours on the reefs and bays—they only have rules for opihi picking! I need a full copy of all the rules and the CRV...

April 3, 2013

DOCARE—stand up paddle boards ele’ele Japanese with over 12 trucks from southshore and lihue

Witnessed one local-not of westside giving lessons to 2 foreigners for over an hour from 9:30am- _over the reef into puolo point reefs (pictures)..i witnessed the one person on the board diving and he had a red floater buoy.not flag---one guy on board did not stand up..i witnessed a lifeguard go out with surfboard but he didn’t go near them and he himself was diving on the “ledge” and got something...

Akana and Rutherford came and I spoke with them. Akana was alright and Rutherford was informative. Rutherford said he has years with DLNR and very good friends with Aila but I found out he just moved here and working on the westside for less than a year. He tried to tell me that anyone can do what they want because there were no rules on the point!!!

1. Complaint filed (by I. Freitas and witnessed by all employees of the refuse trash facility) because Rutherford was speeding and passing a car on the salt pond road near the refuse and almost hit a walking pedestrian on the side of the road as he was going to salt pans to meet me.

April 2, 2013

April 1, 2013 mon

March, 2013-Police report: Follow up on Pimental driving on puolo point beach and reef, drinking, and having sex with a minor-police was called and he was caught while having sex in his truck while parked dug in the sand near reef..Joe Kamai and Nolan Holi witnessed his entry and activities.

March 28, 2013

After DOT sweep (Miller quite RUDE, Neves is very cooperative and nice)

March 27, 2013

Holo holo 2, Capt. Andy 1, blue dolphin 2, Northern Star, Bubbles below surrounded whale and their babies in front of Puolo point in less than 50 yards from reef—they turned around and plotted intersecting course and surrounded pod for at least 30 minutes before further harassing and surrounding whales and orcas in Kaumakani bay and at salt pond and puolo point.

March 18, 2013



Raft company using private slips in local small boat harbor to do business(drop and pick up)-need rules to review-witnessed diving and walking on reefs in Kaumakani and disturbing fishermen and fishing grounds, traversing and speeding scuba tours at salt pond finally seen and approached.

March 15, 2013 1:30pm burning donuts near Nolan Holi watchtower at kuunukaiole, salt ponds witnessed by j. kamai and r. libre and reported by n. holi



March 14, 2013

Sent letter to mission on : catamaran and boats surround whale pod at puolo point and traffic at night at puolo and inquiry if an officer can be sent.

March 27, 2013 weds

Airport security Sweep of trash and illegal campers (Securitas- Hurley, Rita, Kanoho , DOT- Neves, Miller, +2)—
Report to AILA will be made in 2 week.

March 28, 2013


After sweep there were 2 tents went up—don't know who—called P. Hurley Securitas from DOT and he will send someone down.



Homeless asian woman sets up tea time, she solicits men and beg families on the beach, authorities do not remove vagrant but employee men visits her at night (witness claims), requests to remove her is ignored, the one girl has grown to 2 girls now in the bushes...**Lineal descendants and native fishermen requests strongly for her immediate removal.** She uses bathroom in native bushes, sand, and ocean and walk the trails alone in the back where she is sometimes picked up by vehicles. Local complaints and encounters undesirable.



Catamaran parked in bay on reef while Dogs desiccate, Dig up, and urinate on native kupee habitat. Cultural sign was removed.



Constantly too close to shore headed to Kaumakani: request their route 1-3mile out shipping lanes traverse



march 28, 2013 Salt pond County Park – Dog on the beach—was reminded of no animals in park or sand or water---she claimed she does this all the time since she arrived in islands!



3.12.13-Been seen there before-Salt Pond and Puolo point –
Tour guide with 2 tourists- fishing shoreline commercial, speeding on sand, on sand making donuts, on reef and sand-
looking for place to throw in their fishing gear! When asking who they were, they left quickly!





2.26.13 Complaints for over 10 years go unheard by County. RAW Sewage always over flows after “Church on the Beach” activities and unpermitted ocean events. Sewage and bathrooms were never put in correctly stated KWWC kupuna and county worker late J. Vidinha. Marketing by county and commercial operators causing over capacity, Health Hazard by sewage and pesticides, displacement of fishermen and regional native Hawaiians, and spilling into the Salt pans and coral reefs. Locals complain “This is not Lydgate or Po’ipu beach. Quality of life in this native area is abused and violated.

FEB. 17, 2013

Request removal of homeless on Puolo point from Kuleana



(STATE PROP.) Feb. 17, 2013- NEW HOMELESS

WOMAN MOVES IN and SETS UP CAMP ON PUOLO POINT; VISITED/ALLOWED BY AIRPORT PERSONEL; when asked she said the other girl said it was alright to move in. Vehicles visit this area late nights; she arrived from the eastside and was directed to this area in the bushes and she made a clearing for herself. “Church on the Beach” activities have been causing community and resources conflicts since they have been coming to this “not so traveled” area and now peaceful salt ponds and surrounding areas are having negative impacts to practices, reefs, sensitive nurseries and habitat, and water.



(STATE PROP.) Feb. 6, 2013- Witness (5) state

Larry Miller (state airports division) and allows and visits (late nights and afternoons by DLNR employees) this single homeless “asian” national woman over a month camping in bushes, Miller states “no permit area camping”, she hangs her laundry on the native plants and is visited by vehicles late at night. Incident of Airport Fence damages claim that the

domestic started at these women's illegal camps. (complaints filed by lineal descendants of that area). Feb. 20, 2013 11pm government employee visits homeless asian woman late night for 45 minutes in the dark-no camp light seen (witnessed by 2 puolo maka'ainana)...said to be soliciting men at the beach and puolo point days and night. Requests by lineal and cultural descendants and fishermen of the area for the removal of these homeless women.



(STATE PROP.) Feb. 17, 2013- Tourists and newcomers to Puolo point manmade road ...in sand less than 3 feet from water-native species habitat/estuary

RE:2.12.13 konahema moku complaints report: BLATANT CORAL REEF HABITAT VIOLATIONS and NON-COMPLIANCE TO STATE, CULTURAL, and NATIONAL LAWS in REGARDS to CIVIL/HUMAN RIGHTS, CORAL REEF, CULTURAL PRACTICES INJURIES, CLEAN WATER ACT,



Feb. 12, 2013- 5 catamarans invade and push out native gatherers and practitioners-Coral Reef Injuries, Too close to shore, NO DIVE FLAGS and over nearly 49x5=260 people in our gathering food area (huggie point)



Feb. 12. 2013- All these people were sent to shoreline fishing area on local roads of Kaumakani and salt pond park by commercial operators.."OUR SACRED AREAS HAVE BEEN INVADED BY WAIKIKI". According to our survey, visitors are solicited to go to these places as well as Kalaheo and Po'ipu residents coming to these areas on a regular basis-trying to inflict the current county walk-path agenda in our area....no visitors' destination nor cultural permission to enter our ICE BOX SACRED AREAS....poaching everything, homeless moving in, feces on the beaches and sand, over-capacity, trash, pollution of their oils and lotions in our seaweed nurseries, foreign campers, speeding, and criminal activities are increasing in these areas of the native gatherers.



(STATE)Feb.9, 2013

catamarans pushes out native practitioners, gatherers, and fishermen from limu nurseries in bay as they were diving earlier- no commercial dive flags ! fishermen gets out of the water and stands by their truck and yells in anger

(COUNTY) Lifeguards do their exercises with jet skis (behavior of lifeguards with their vehicles and jet skis in and out of the water has a lot to be desired and needs decorum, management, and accountability). Lifeguards tell their friends and family to bring their dogs and park on the shoreline sand on the state side of this beach! Employees take arbitrary liberties. This dog is right in front of lifeguard station and they do nothing to enforce rules—Counted 20 dogs that are brought to the beach to use the bathroom and harass beachgoers and fishermen. Tourist diving with nets catching baby fishes, seaweed, crabs, sea urchins and cucumbers, and injuring coral with chemicals and physical damages. The reefs show the results of this new increased activities solicited by boat operators and tourist magazines. NO ANIMALS (even on leash) IN COUNTY PARK SO THEY GO ON THE SAND WHERE STATE DOES NOT ENFORCE—THUS WE HAVE URINE AND FECES FILLED SAND and plants!

2.1.13 County Lifeguards and other officials DO NOTHING as these violations are a regular daily chore of these people that have moved to the westside or actually come from Kalaheo and Po'ipu and Lihu'e to do their activities here in our sacred areas (i.e. use sandy beaches, ocean, and parking lots to leave their animals' feces and urine, comb reefs with nets taking live baby fishes and crustaceans, sea urchins, and live shells and coral,...)

County lifeguards send their families and dogs and jet skis and atv to the state side of beach of puolo point! Events use the state side of the beach- no permits as well as traverse through county to get to the state waters and beach---no enforcement or management adhered.

KWWC is now official "adopt-a-park" maintenance management 2013-2014 eventually signing an agreement and contract for the Salt Pond park and old Dog pound- "KWWC-Ahupua'a Community Education and restoration/enforcement base yard"

Complaints of "Church on the Beach" creating more problems with over-capacity, displacement of native practitioners and maoli, money exchanges, increasing homeless to area by soliciting the area, their people walk and impact the reefs in huge numbers all at once, constantly overflows sewage, maolis have expressed anger in being displaced from their regular routine after church, sewage smells and over flows when this group is there, this church has a huge property in lawai with their church there, they lure people to bring people to salt pond and they encourage homeless to this county park and state properties, homeless and vagrants have increase since this church started coming to this native area.



Feb. 2, 2013 (STATE) Lude public behavior (copulating in the water) by tourists caught by local youth during the afternoon hours at salt pond in the state side of park. Quite disgusting and unacceptable.

2 events with Waimea Town Celebration paddle board and one man canoe that traverse too close to shore and over reefs and native fishing/diving areas and without proper permits or cultural protocol adherence. Willful intrusions to cultural nurseries.
