January Legislative Briefing Objectives

The Legislative Briefing is being called to convene decision-makers and provide information about the legacy of the ORMP, its continuing value, and our vision for its future.

Proposed Agenda:

- I: Provide a brief background about the CZM Program, the ORMP, and plan partners
 - Overview of the CZM Program, State/Federal Relationship, and CZM Objectives and Policies
- II: Discuss the ORMP & ORMP Update
 - What is the ORMP
 - Review recent ORMP partner accomplishments and Action Team efforts
 - Opportunities for officials and constituents to be involved through the Statewide Public Listening Sessions, request for support in outreach to members of the public
 - Top priorities for the next 5-year planning horizon (to be decided during the course of the update) will translate into 1-3 projects designed to formulate policy outcomes
- III: Lay the groundwork for a return visit to the legislature in early 2020 to report-back on the finalized ORMP
