Statutory Mandate

HRS §205A-62 calls for the lead agency to 'Review and periodically update the Hawaii Ocean Resources Management Plan'.

The 2019-2020 planning cycle will create the fifth version of the ORMP, with updates historically occurring about every 5 years. (1985, 1991, 1998 [Plan Review], 2006, 2013)
