Since the HBGN already made its decisions on these names, it shouldn't have to review them again. I'll do some checking to include any comments that I can find to back up the decisions and will assemble a spreadsheet for Jenny, so that she can process them as soon as possible. I hope to get that done this week prior to the September meeting. I'm cc'ing Jenny to give her a heads up.

I plan to completely review the spreadsheets for all of the islands in the coming weeks (and probably months) to identify and resolve any discrepancies between the GNIS and alreadydecided HBGN corrections.
