AGENDA ITEM 2: Review of Meeting Minutes for June 14, 2017

Motion: Ms. McEldowney moved to approve the minutes of the June 14, 2017 meeting, and Mr. Cummins seconded the motion.

The members present voted as follows: three Ayes and one Abstention (Mr. Mills) to approve the meeting minutes of June 14, 2017.

AGENDA ITEM 3: Public Comments.

Mr. Camara is working with Frank Trusdell at Hawaiian Volcano Observatory (HVO) reviewing names for geologic maps for Mauna Loa that Frank is printing. The color coded spreadsheet indicates which names he will use on his maps based on what is in the GNIS. Mr. Camara asked that the HBGN review the place names on the spreadsheet at its next meeting.

Mr. Camara also asked if there is a process by which HBGN can join or combine en masse place names that start with “lua,” “lae,” “pu‘u,” and “kipuka” pursuant to HBGN naming guidelines, then go back later for more in-depth review and research. Mr. Mills is agreeable to the mass compression, but the Status Codes of those place names should remain “3” (more research needed), to ensure that the HBGN goes back and does the research.

Ms. Louis reminded Mr. Camara that the HBGN will need to cite sources when decisions are made. In some cases, in the absence of written documentation, “personal observation” or “direct experience” might be acceptable. Mr. Mills cautioned against modern interpretation of historical place names.

Mr. Camara pointed to a feature on Frank Trusdell’s 2017 map labeled “Mokaoku” in Hilo Bay, upper right hand side of map (https://pubs.usgs.gov/sim/2932/a/sim2932a_sheet1.pdf). It’s also in the GNIS that way, but all other maps that he’s seen it spelled “Makaoku.” He would like to Board to review this name at its next meeting.
