History: Projected from decimal degrees to UTM Zone 4 NAD83 HARN using ArcToolbox. Removed extraneous fields (e.g., State Code). The census blocks layer was clipped to the State GIS coastline, which resulted in 2 census blocks being deleted, so those blocks were added back into the layer – therefore, the coastline for the census layers is slightly different than the State GIS coastline. Specifically:

- Block number 150030001122002, population = 95 (Kuapa Isle, Hawaii Kai, Oahu)
- Block number 150039814001002, population = 15 (islet just west of Sand Island, Oahu).

This revised coastline was then used to clip the remaining 2010 census layers - block groups, census county divisions, census designated places and census tracts.
