Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 226-63 requires the TOD Council to:

- (5) Review all capital improvement project requests to the legislature for transitoriented development projects, including mixed use and affordable and rental housing projects, on state lands within county-designated transit-oriented development zones or within a one-half-mile radius of public transit stations, if a county has not designated transit-oriented development zones;
- (6) Recommend policy, regulatory, and statutory changes, and identify resource strategies for the successful execution of the [TOD] strategic plan;

<u>HB 1185/SB 1191 - Relating to Transit-Oriented Development, (BED144)</u> (Rep. Nakamura/Sen. Kouchi)

 Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds and appropriates funds for transit-oriented development projects in the State of Hawai'i Strategic Plan for Transit-Oriented Development.
