The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (“**DCCA**”) is currently in the renewal process for Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P., doing business as Oceanic Time Warner Cable’s (“**Oceanic**”) Oahu cable television franchise. Accordingly, DCCA is holding a community meeting to obtain the public’s general input and comments on how you or your organization might be able to benefit from services provided by Oceanic and its cable television system on Oahu, and to provide feedback on the services currently being provided by Oceanic.

This community meeting is part of the ascertainment of community needs and interests for Oceanic’s cable television service. Your participation, as an individual or representative of a community organization, will help assist DCCA in determining what it should consider in the renewal process.

At the community meeting, information will be provided on the cable television franchising process. All interested persons will be afforded the opportunity to submit their comments, both orally and in writing, at the time of the community meeting and will be asked to fill out a brief questionnaire to help identify cable-related community needs and interests on Oahu.
