

OCEANIC TIME WARNER CABLE
OAHU FRANCHISE RENEWAL PROCESS
(FEBRUARY 25, 2009 UPDATE)

On April 20, 2007, Oceanic Time Warner Cable (“Oceanic”) notified the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA), of its intent to seek a renewal of its Oahu franchise for cable service. This franchise term currently expires on December 31, 2009.

After the initial plan was established, the DCCA commenced and completed the engineering, financial, and franchise compliance reviews, held three public comment meetings to gather public input, created and distributed a questionnaire and customer satisfaction survey, and held a series of interviews/meetings with individuals and groups from the government, educational and non-profit sectors.

The following is an update to our anticipated timeline of the rest of the activities scheduled for this renewal process:

<u>Anticipated Dates in 2009</u>	<u>Activity</u>
February	Post the Community Ascertainment and Related Activities report to the CATV website.
March through April	Oceanic to review the Community Ascertainment and Related Activities report.
May through June	Oceanic to submit its application; DCCA will review the application.
June or July	Public Hearing on Oceanic’s application.
August	DCCA will consider the public’s input from the Public Hearing.
September	DCCA decision on Oceanic’s application.

As a reminder, once the public hearing is scheduled, notice will be published in a Honolulu newspaper and also on DCCA Cable Television Division’s website.
