Re: Letter Order – Extension of Time for Submission of Joint Schedule  
for PEG Capital Fund Payments

On January 14, 2010, in Decision and Order No. 346 (“**D&O 346**”), Section IV.J.2, the Director of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (“**DCCA**”) directed Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P. (“**TWE**”) to meet with the designated PEG Access Organization (“currently ‘**Ōlelo**”) and develop a plan and schedule for the capital fund payments to ‘**Ōlelo** for the remaining balance of the first five-year period of the franchise (2011-2014). **TWE** is then required to submit an agreed upon schedule to **DCCA** by August 1, 2010.

On July 26, 2010, **DCCA** received your July 23, 2010 letter on behalf of **TWE** requesting an extension of time for submission of a joint schedule for PEG Capital Fund payments. The July 23, 2010 letter informed **DCCA** that **TWE** and ‘**Ōlelo** have met and discussed a plan and schedule for the Capital Fund payments for 2011-2014 but have not yet reached agreement upon a schedule of payments. **TWE** indicated that both **TWE** and ‘**Ōlelo**, however, believe that additional time would be helpful during which the parties can work cooperatively and in good faith towards developing an agreed upon schedule for the Capital Fund payments. **TWE** and ‘**Ōlelo** therefore jointly requested a three (3) month extension of time, or until November 1, 2010, to submit the agreed upon schedule, or to inform **DCCA** that the parties have not been able to reach an agreement on the scheduled of payments.

Accordingly, **DCCA** grants a three (3) month extension of time from August 1, 2010 to November 1, 2010, for **TWE** to submit an agreed upon schedule for Capital Fund payments for the PEG Access Facilities and Equipment for the remaining balance



of the first five-year period of the franchise (2011-2014). During this extension period, TWE shall confer with 'Ōlelo, the current designated PEG Access Organization, and develop a plan and schedule for the Capital Fund payments for the period of 2011-2014.

Except as otherwise provided in this Letter Order, the remaining provisions of Decision and Order No. 346 (including but not limited to Section IV.J.2) shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

Dear Mr. Sonobe:

Pursuant to Section IV.J.2. of Decision and Order No. 346 (January 14, 2010) ("D&O 346"), Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P. ("Oceanic") and the designated PEG Access Organization, 'Olelo Community Media ("'Olelo") are required to meet and develop a plan and schedule for the Capital Fund payments to 'Olelo for the first five-year period of the franchise (2011-2014). Oceanic is then required to submit the "agreed upon schedule" by August 1, 2010.

As discussed with the Cable Division earlier this week, Oceanic and 'Olelo have met and conferred to develop the required plan and schedule for the Capital Fund payments for 2011-2014, and 'Olelo has provided information to Oceanic for its consideration; however, the parties have not developed an agreed-upon schedule as of the date of this letter. The parties, however, believe that additional time would be helpful to implement the intent of Section IV.J.2. for the parties to work cooperatively and in good faith towards developing an agreed-upon schedule for the Capital Fund payments, and with additional time, the parties will continue to discuss this matter with the hopes of reaching a mutually-agreeable schedule for submission to the Director and the Cable Division.


