Re: Letter Order — Final Payment of 2010 Access Operating Fees and Capital Fund Payments to Olelo, Hoike, Na Leo, and Akaku

Pursuant to Letter Orders dated January 28, 2010, February 9, 2010, and June 22, 2010, the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("**DCCA**") directed Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P. ("**TWE**") to pay a total of seventy-five percent (75%) of the respective 2010 Access Operating Fees and also to pay a total of seventy-five percent (75%) of the respective 2010 capital fund payments to the following public, educational, and governmental ("**PEG**") access organizations: Hoike: Kauai Community Television, Inc. ("**Hoike**"), Na Leo O Hawaii, Inc. ("**Na Leo**"), Olelo Community Television ("**Olelo**") and Akaku: Maui Community Television ("**Akaku**"), (collectively "**incumbent PEG access organizations**").

TWE was also directed to deposit and maintain the balance of the 2010 Access Operating Fees and the balance of the 2010 capital fund payments in separate interest-bearing accounts in federally insured financial institutions pending further instruction from DCCA. In addition, TWE was allowed to recover the reasonable costs of administering the bank accounts (including the tax impact of any interest earned) from the interest on the accounts. Any remaining interest earned on the bank accounts would then be prorated and disbursed as further directed by DCCA.

On September 20, 2010, the State Procurement Office ("SPO") extended the procurement exemption for DCCA's contracts with the incumbent PEG access organizations for an additional three-month period, from October 1, 2010 to December

31, 2010. DCCA and each incumbent PEG access organization subsequently agreed to extend their respective PEG access agreement for another three-month period from October 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.

Accordingly, DCCA hereby directs TWE to:

1. Pay the remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the respective 2010 Access Operating Fees plus any interest accrued as of August 31, 2010, subject to the provisions in this Letter Order, to Olelo, Na Leo, Hoike, and Akaku.
2. By separate check, pay the remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the respective 2010 capital fund payments plus any interest accrued as of August 31, 2010, subject to the provisions in this Letter Order, to Olelo, Na Leo, Hoike, and Akaku.
3. On Friday, October 1, 2010, TWE shall make the payment checks available for pick up by authorized representatives of each PEG access organization as follows:
 - For 'Olelo at 200 Akamainui St., Mililani, Hawaii 96789;
 - For Na Leo at 548 Kanoelehua Ave., Hilo, HI 96720;
 - For Hoike at 3022 Peleke St., Lihue, HI 96766; and
 - For Akaku at 350 Hoohana St., Kahului HI 96732.

For the checks not picked up by 4:00 p.m. on October 1, 2010, TWE shall mail out these checks directly to the appropriate PEG access organization by Monday, October 4, 2010. TWE shall send copies of each of the payment checks to DCCA by October 12, 2010.


4. TWE shall maintain separate accounting records for the 2010 Access Operating Fees and capital fund payments attributable to each PEG access organization. Upon request from DCCA, TWE shall promptly provide DCCA with documentation of the bank accounts and accounting records regarding the 2010 Access Operating Fees and capital contributions.
5. TWE may recover reasonable costs of administering the bank accounts, including the tax impact of any interest earned, from the interest on the accounts.
6. Any interest earned on the bank accounts shall be prorated and disbursed as further directed by DCCA. TWE shall maintain separate accounting

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records for any interest earned on the 2010 Access Operating Fees and for any interest earned on the capital contributions.
