Re: Oceanic Time Warner Cable LLC's Request for Intervention in DCCA's Public Hearing on Ho'ike: Kauai Community Television's Application for Designation as a PEG Access Organization

The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("DCCA") received Oceanic Time Warner Cable LLC's ("**Oceanic**") January 8, 2013 letter and request to intervene in the public hearing for Ho'ike: Kauai Community Television Inc.'s ("**Ho'ike**") October 3, 2012 Application to Provide PEG Access Services to Kauai ("**Ho'ike's Application**"). According to your letter, Oceanic represents that: (1) Oceanic has a substantial interest in the outcome of the designation of Ho'ike as a PEG access organization, (2) Oceanic's intervention will not unduly delay the public hearing nor is it intended to harass, hinder or prejudice the rights of Ho'ike, and (3) the denial of Oceanic's request to intervene would substantially prejudice the rights of Oceanic. Your letter further states that if its request to intervene is granted, Oceanic may submit written questions to Ho'ike about its Application and may make reasonable requests for supporting and clarifying documentation to Ho'ike.

Based on the foregoing and pursuant to HRS section 440G-8.3(b) and DCCA's September 2, 2011 "Guidelines to Designate PEG Access Organizations Pursuant to Act 19 (SLH 2011)", DCCA hereby grants Oceanic's request to intervene in the public hearing process for Ho'ike's Application; provided that Oceanic's intervention shall be subject to the following:



1. Oceanic's written questions and requests to Ho'ike for supporting and clarifying documentation shall be limited in quantity and scope to what is reasonably necessary to allow Oceanic to formulate its testimony at the public hearing on Ho'ike's Application;
2. Such questions and documentation requests shall be limited to matters that are materially relevant to Oceanic and specifically relate to the designation of Ho'ike as a PEG provider on the island of Kauai;
3. Oceanic shall submit its written questions and requests for supporting and clarifying documentation to Ho'ike by March 25, 2013 (with a copy to DCCA);
4. Ho'ike shall provide its responses and documents to Oceanic by April 8, 2013 (with a copy to DCCA); and
5. No follow-up questions or requests for documents shall be allowed.

For your information, DCCA accepted Ho'ike's Application on March 8, 2013 and intends to hold a public hearing on Ho'ike's Application in the near future.
