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REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PUBLIC, EDUCATION AND GOVERNMENT ACCESS SERVICES ISSUED

HONOLULU – The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA) announced that a Request for Proposal (RFP) to operate, maintain and manage public, educational and governmental (PEG) channels, funds, facilities and equipment was issued by the State Procurement Office (SPO) on May 20, 2010.

DCCA is seeking nonprofit organizations to manage PEG access funds and operate PEG access channels, facilities and equipment in each county and provide noncommercial PEG access services which include: training the public to create programming; facilitation of the production and creation of programming by members of the general public, educational institutions, and government; and cable-casting public, educational and governmental programming on access channels.

Currently, the PEG access organizations are 'Ōlelo on Oahu, Na Leo on Hawai'i, Hoike on Kauai and Akaku on Maui. The contracts with the PEG access organizations are subject to the State procurement code.

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
