

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2009 Annual Activity Report

Executive Summary

March 3, 2010

Programming:

This past year continues to a year of transition in local program production. As noted last year, interest in training by producers has grown but new program production for showing on Na Leo has decreased slightly. More and more clients are purchasing their own equipment, but need Na Leo training in order to use it. Consequently, program production is now primarily oriented more to their own uses, particularly the Internet, than the local Community. Consequently, the role of Na Leo is slowly changing from showing programs only to becoming an active Community program producer. To illustrate, Na Leo O Hawaii staff has produced 103 new programs during the past year. These events were primarily community meetings, hearings, etc. This is a definite niche that needs to be filled as coverage of local community meetings, hearings and other happenings is lacking otherwise. The change to program producer has NOT resulted in any unavailability of equipment to clients.

With the advent of Na Leo's server based playback system and now web site, Na Leo has also expanded the hours of cable casting on Ch 52, 53 and 54 to take advantage of the opportunities this combination offers to expand our audience.

You will also note a significant decrease in hours devoted to government programs. Na Leo O Hawaii is not certain why this is so, but suspect that it correlates with the contract the County has with Out Of The Sea productions

Training

The characteristics of training have continued to evolve in favor of one-on-one instruction rather than class instruction. Almost 100% of advanced instruction now consists of individual tutoring. Hopefully, the greater individual attention will improve the learning experience, resulting in better programs and reduced "hand-holding" during the editing process. The results are mixed so far. One thing is clear however: the completion rate has improved significantly. Adding Final Cut Pro to the edit choices has piqued interest as students have two choices in professional editing suites, Adobe Premiere CS4 and Final Cut Pro. The choice in editing programs has the additional advantage in that the two editing suites are almost clones of each other; if you know one, you practically know the other. One thing is clear, however: as the economy has worsened,

people have time for their avocation and interest in taking classes has re-kindled dramatically as reflected in the training statistics.

Outreach

By filming different community hearings in Hilo and Kona, and outfitting the camera persons with distinctive Na Leo O Hawaii shirts, Na Leo O Hawaii is becoming widely known in Big Island communities for local coverage as the only local video station - we receive more and more requests for coverage. Na Leo's cooperative program with the Police Department, The Big Island's Most Wanted, is also finding an appreciative audience both in the Police Department as well as the public at large.

Na Leo also accommodates a myriad of community groups, and the U.S. Census Bureau, by making our conference room available for meetings and the occasional Hilo - Kona videoconference at no charge to the community organization. In addition, Na Leo staff serves as volunteers at many organizations.

Inventory

Na Leo strives to keep its equipment and software up to date to include editing software. A complete Inventory for Hilo and Kona is attached.

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

Big Island police arrest 3 on 'Most Wanted'

HILO — Big Island police have arrested three men who were featured on the most recent episode of the CrimeStoppers television program "Hawaii Island's Most Wanted."

In the Feb. 6 episode, police asked for the public's help in identifying a man who was photographed by a surveillance camera at the scene of several car break-ins in Hilo. On Feb. 25, police arrested Brian E. Perreira, 32, in connection with the case and later charged him with four counts of second-degree theft, three counts of unauthorized entry into a motor vehicle, and one count each of criminal property damage, unauthorized control of a propelled vehicle, second-degree burglary and first-degree trespassing. His bail was set at \$55,000.

The television program also asked for public help in locating Richard Davis Potter, 26 and Mark Yun Jin McCurley, 25. Potter was arrested Feb. 20 and later charged with burglary and second-degree theft. His bail was set at \$7,200.

McCurley was arrested Feb. 27 and later charged with burglary and unauthorized entry into a motor vehicle. His bail was set at \$4,400.

CrimeStoppers Hilo Inc. said "Hawaii Island's Most Wanted" was inspired by the national TV show "America's Most Wanted." Since the program began airing in February 2007, police have asked for help in locating 56 people who were either missing or crime suspects. Thanks to tips from the public, police cleared 31 of those cases.

The program airs on Na Leo O Hawaii Community Television Channel 54 at 5 p.m. Sundays and 5:30 p.m. Fridays. It also airs intermittently on Channel 53.
