Dear Ms. Lopez and Messrs. Denecke, McLaughlin, and Robertson:

This is to clarify two items relating to the election of a PEG board member as documented in the statewide PEG Plan ("Plan"). First, the voter criteria contained in the fourth paragraph on page 6 of the Plan states that meeting *any* of the three (3) criteria will make an individual eligible to vote in the election. Second, a board member must be a resident of the county that is served by the PEG access organization. This is a current by-law requirement for all PEG organizations.
