Clyde,

This person called and didn't want to give out his name in fear of retribution. He did tell me that he was calling from a neighbor island. Had a few concerns re PEG access:

- 1) Feels PEG entity is losing sight of their mission statement.
- 2) Shouldn't be doing in house productions - Underbidding so other producers/public can't get it.
- 3) PEGs feel that the public have no right in their affairs. The PEGs are in a power play position and they just do what they want to do.
- 4) Employees that work for the PEGs don't have a say or an avenue to voice their concerns about the way things are done. If they have a complaint against the executive director, they don't even have the ability to bring it to the attention of the board.
- 5) Feels there is collusion among the different nonprofit organizations. There are board members that may belong to as many as 9 other nonprofits.
Nonprofits making alliance with one another. Feels there should be more oversight over nonprofits, i.e., management audit, etc. Board members are picked because they can be "manipulated" by other members.
