ORDER

I.

By application filed on November 19, 2001, INTELLIGENT SWITCHING & SOFTWARE, LLC (Applicant), requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to provide resold telecommunications services within the State of Hawaii.

By letter dated June 19, 2002, and filed on June 24, 2002, Applicant filed a request to withdraw its application.¹ Upon review, the commission finds good cause to grant Applicant's request, without prejudice.

¹By letters dated and filed on November 29, 2001, and May 21, 2002, the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (Consumer Advocate) informed Applicant that it had not been served with copies of the application, and that in order for the Consumer Advocate to complete its review of the merits of the application, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 6-61-18, two copies of same should be served upon it. In its May 21, 2002 letter to Applicant, the Consumer Advocate gave Applicant a May 31, 2002 deadline to provide it with copies of the application. The Consumer Advocate did not receive copies of the application. On June 10, 2002, the Consumer Advocate submitted its statement of position


THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. The application of INTELLIGENT SWITCHING & SOFTWARE, LLC, filed on November 19, 2001, is withdrawn, without prejudice.




