ORDER

By Decision and Order No. 18876, filed on September 5, 2001, we approved the application of VITO NGUYEN RICHARDS (Applicant) for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to limousines. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated September 5, 2001, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified January 5, 2002, as the deadline for compliance. Our letter of


September 5, 2001, also stated that Applicant could request an extension of 30 days to comply. On January 3, 2002, Applicant filed a request for an extension to comply, which the commission approved on January 4, 2002.

The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 18876. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 18876 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 18876 is voided and this docket is closed.




