

ORDER

I.

By letter filed on October 30, 2002, PLAYPEN WORLD, INC., dba FRIENDS HAWAII (Petitioner), requests commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1511-C (CPCN No. 1511-C). Under CPCN No. 1511-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification, limited to utilizing motor vehicles with a maximum manufacturer's seating capacity of 15 passengers. As part of its request, Petitioner returned CPCN No. 1511-C to the commission.

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.

II.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under CPCN No. 1511-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.


2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations, and shall ensure that the vehicle identification cards for the motor vehicle equipment currently registered in its name are removed from the files of the Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 30 days from the date of this order.


3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.

4. This docket is closed.




