ORDER

I.

By letters dated October 24 and November 20, 2002, AT&T WIRELESS SERVICES OF HAWAII, INC., as successor-in-interest to HONOLULU CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY, aka HONOLULU CELLULAR, seeks commission approval to voluntarily surrender Honolulu Cellular's certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN).¹ In addition, AT&T Wireless Services of Hawaii, Inc. submitted the requisite public utility fees and annual financial reports. It represents that Honolulu Cellular ceased to exist, as of the year 2000.

In Docket No. 99-0363, these entities represented that, for the time being, "Honolulu Cellular" and "Honolulu Cellular Telephone Company" would continue as trade names.

Upon review, the commission will approve the voluntarily surrender of Honolulu Cellular's CPCN.




THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


