ORDER

I.

On February 3, 2003, TIME WARNER TELECOM OF HAWAII, L.P., dba OCEANIC COMMUNICATIONS, filed transmittal number 03-01. By Order No. 20045, filed on February 26, 2003, and Order No. 20050, filed on March 3, 2003, the commission: (1) suspended the portion of OCEANIC COMMUNICATIONS' transmittal that offered the IBL and VersiPak bundled packages (section 5.7); and (2) directed Oceanic Communications to file a separate application, with supporting cost data, if it intended to offer the IBL and VersiPak bundled packages.

Oceanic Communications responded to the commission's orders by filing its first and second amended transmittals, on March 3 and 6, 2003, respectively. The amended transmittals remove in their entirety the IBL and VersiPak bundled packages (section 5.7).¹ Thus, Oceanic Communications no longer intends to offer the IBL or VersiPak bundled packages.

¹The amended transmittals also remove the VersiPak IPRI (section 5.8).

By Order No. 20095, filed on March 24, 2003, the commission allowed the first and second amended transmittals to take effect, effective from March 6, 2003.² Accordingly, the commission will close the instant docket.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the instant docket is closed.


