ORDER

I.

By Order No. 20057 filed on March 6, 2003, the commission ordered HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. (HECO) and the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (Consumer Advocate) to meet informally to formulate the issues, procedures, and schedule with respect to this proceeding, and to submit a stipulated prehearing order for commission approval on or before April 7, 2003. By letter dated and filed on April 7, 2003, HECO requests an extension of one week to April 14, 2003 to file the stipulated prehearing order, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 6-61-23.


Upon review, the commission finds good cause to enlarge the time to file the stipulated prehearing order. Accordingly, we conclude that HECO's request for an extension of time to file the stipulated prehearing order should be approved.

II.


