ORDER

By Decision and Order No. 19761, filed on November 4, 2002, we approved the application of ERIC J. RAGRAGOLA, dba ERIC'S TRUCKING (Applicant), for a certificate to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the dump truck classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to Applicant, dated November 4, 2002, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified March 4, 2003, as the deadline for compliance.


On March 6, 2002, Applicant filed a request for a 30-day extension to comply. The request was approved on March 6, 2003.


The extended due date has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 19761. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 19761 should be voided.
