ORDER

I.

Background

On July 8, 2003, in Decision and Order No. 20309, the commission approved the application of NATURAL ISLANDS HAWAII CORPORATION ("Applicant") for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within 120 days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order.

We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we sent a letter to

Applicant, dated July 8, 2003, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified November 8, 2003, as the deadline for compliance.

The 120-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 20309. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 20309 should be voided.

II.


Order

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 20309 is voided and this docket is closed.




