ORDER

By Order No. 19871, filed on December 12, 2002, certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 925-C ("Certificate No. 925-C"), held by POLYNESIAN EXPRESS CORPORATION ("Petitioner"), was placed on inactive status until December 12, 2003. Order No. 19871 stated that if Certificate No. 925-C was not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., December 12, 2003, the commission would deem it abandoned and revoked.

By letter received by the commission on February 14, 2003, Petitioner requested reactivation of Certificate No. 925-C. Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19(b), a certificate may be reactivated upon fulfilling the requirements for reactivation. Order No. 19871 informed the Petitioner that these requirements included, but were not limited to, the filing of appropriate insurance documents and the publication of a lawful tariff.

By letter dated February 18, 2003, the commission requested that Petitioner submit the following: (1) proof of

insurance; (2) a lawful tariff; (3) a vehicle inventory list; and (4) certificates of registration or ownership. The commission did not receive the requested documents.

December 12, 2003 has passed and Certificate No. 925-C was not reactivated. We, thus, find that there is good cause to revoke Certificate No. 925-C.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Certificate No. 925-C is revoked, and this docket is closed.


