time, until February 27, 2004, to execute an Agreement.² It makes its request pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 6-61-23(a)(2).

HELCO explains:

1. On December 19, 2003, Hess Microgen LLC, The Fairmont Orchid's consultant, timely executed the Agreement.

2. Due to health problems, the Agreement was not delivered to The Fairmont Orchid's corporate offices in Toronto, Canada for signature until mid-January 2004.

3. Once The Fairmont Orchid signs the Agreement, HELCO will sign as well.³

HELCO and The Fairmont Orchid have completed negotiating an Agreement. Hess Microgen LLC timely signed the Agreement on The Fairmont Orchid's behalf. All that remains is for The Fairmont Orchid and HELCO to sign the Agreement. The commission will approve The Fairmont Orchid's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that The Fairmont Orchid's request for an extension of time, until February 27, 2004, to execute a standard interconnection agreement with HELCO, is approved.






