THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's request to surrender COA 00-0332 to operate as a reseller of intrastate telecommunications services is approved, effective from the date of this order. Petitioner shall promptly return COA 00-0332 to the commission.


2. The customer notification requirement set forth in HAR § 6-80-123(a) is waived.

3. This docket is closed.






