ORDER

I.

Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

On May 12, 2004, I. DOI HAULING CONTRACTOR, INC. ("Petitioner") filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender its authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 134-C ("Certificate No. 134-C"). Under Certificate No. 134-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the general commodities and dump truck classifications.

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate its authority.

II.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's authority to transport property under Certificate No. 134-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.


2. Petitioner shall surrender its certificate and remove any markings from the vehicles used in its operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 30 days from the date of this order.


3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, it may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.

4. This docket is closed.




