ORDER

NPCR, INC., dba NEXTEL PARTNERS ("Nextel Partners"), requests the commission's designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") for the service area of the State of Hawaii.¹ Nextel Partners makes its request in accordance with: (1) sections 254(e) and 214(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996; and (2) Hawaii Administrative Rules § 6-81-9(a). Nextel Partners requests the designation as a prerequisite to receiving federal universal service support.

Nextel Partners served copies of its application upon the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Division of Consumer Advocacy ("Consumer Advocate"). On June 1, 2004, the Consumer Advocate filed its position statement, recommending that the commission deny Nextel Partners' request for designation as an ETC.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS that by July 2, 2004, Nextel Partners shall file its response to the Consumer Advocate's

position statement. Its response shall include information on all the jurisdictions where Nextel Partners has applied for ETC designation, and where applicable, been denied or approved designation as an ETC and the reasons thereto.
