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
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STIPULATED PROCEDURAL ORDER

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STIPULATED PROCEDURAL ORDER

Amended Order No. 19094, issued on December 11, 2001, and Order No. 19788, issued on November 19, 2002, requires Hawaii Electric Light Company, Inc. (“HELCO”) and the Division of Consumer Advocacy (collectively, the “parties”) to file with the Commission a joint report on the status of continuing the Stipulation for the temporary

continuation of HELCO's Demand-Side Management ("DSM") programs.¹

By letter dated April 30, 2004, the parties requested an extension of time from April 30, 2004 to May 31, 2004 to file their joint report for the six months ended December 31, 2003. By letter dated May 11, 2004, the Commission approved the parties' request for an extension of time from April 30 2004 to May 31, 2004 to file their joint report.

By Stipulated Procedural Order No. 21035, filed June 9, 2004, the Commission approved the parties' request for an extension of time, from May 31, 2004 to June 18, 2004, to file their joint report.

The parties require additional time to continue discussions and finalize a joint report. HELCO and the Consumer Advocate request a further extension of time until July 16, 2004 to submit its joint report.


Hawaii Administrative Rules §6-61-23(a)(1) provides the Commission with the discretion, for good cause shown, to enlarge a period by which a required act must be completed, if a written request is made before the expiration of the period originally prescribed. The Commission finds good cause in this instance to enlarge the deadline (from June 18, 2004 to July 16, 2004) to comply with Amended Order No. 19094 and Order No. 19788 and the request is granted and so ordered.


¹ Amended Order No. 19094, issued on December 11, 2001, approved the parties Stipulation to temporarily continue HELCO's DSM programs until one year after the Commission makes a determination of Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc.'s ("HECO") revenue requirements in its next rate case in an interim or final decision and order. Based on the Notice of Intent filed on May 18, 2004, Docket No. 04-0113, HECO plans to file an application to examine its rates using a 2005 test year.


