### Orders

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Petitioner's Certificate No. 1641-C is placed on inactive status for one year, effective from the date of this order.


2. If Certificate No. 1641-C is not reactivated prior to the expiration of the period of inactivity, i.e., within one year from the date of this order, it shall be declared abandoned and revoked. The request to reactivate Certificate No. 1641-C, along with the filing of all required documents necessary for reactivation must be completed prior to the expiration of the inactivity period, or Certificate No. 1641-C shall be revoked.


3. Petitioner shall not transfer her inactive certificate unless Petitioner can first establish good cause to the commission for the transfer, and the commission has approved the request to transfer.
