ORDER

On February 27, 2004, in Decision and Order No. 20828, the commission approved the application of ANTHONY ALLEN LOANDO, dba KAHANAKOA CONSTRUCTION ("Applicant"), for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Hawaii in the dump truck classification. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to void the decision and order. We served Applicant with a copy of the decision and order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the decision and order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122. Additionally, we

sent a letter to Applicant, dated February 27, 2004, which reiterated the commission's requirements and specified June 27, 2004, as the deadline for compliance.

The one hundred and twenty (120)-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth under Decision and Order No. 20828. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 20828 should be voided.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that Decision and Order No. 20828 is voided and this docket is closed.




