In accordance with HRS § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1595-C is terminated, effective from the date of this order.
2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in his operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirements within 15 days from the date of this order.
3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirements within the time period specified, he may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.
4. This docket is closed.
