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ORDER

The deadline for HAWAII WATER SERVICE COMPANY, INC. ("HWSCI") and the Division of Consumer Advocacy ("Consumer Advocate") (collectively, the "Parties") to file their settlement agreement with the commission was December 27, 2004.¹ The corresponding nine (9)-month deadline governing commission action on HWSCI's request for a general rate increase, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 269-16(d), is February 15, 2005.²

The Parties, through HWSCI, requests: (1) an eight (8)-day extension of time, from December 27, 2004 to January 4, 2005, to file their settlement agreement; and (2) a corresponding eight (8)-day extension of time, from February 15, 2005 to February 23, 2005, for the commission to comply with the

nine (9)-month deadline governing commission action, pursuant to HRS § 269-16(d).³

In seeking the additional time to finalize and memorialize the settlement agreement, HWSCI represents:

The Parties believe that this change in the schedule will effectively promote the efficient and cost-effective allocation of the cost-effective [P]arties' respective resources, and can expedite the Commission's review of the subject docket if a final settlement can be reached without having to complete the remaining steps in the regulatory schedule.⁴

The commission finds good cause to approve the Parties' requests for: (1) an eight (8)-day extension of time, until January 4, 2005, for the Parties to file their settlement agreement; and (2) a corresponding eight (8)-day extension of time, until February 23, 2005, for the commission to comply with the nine (9)-month deadline governing commission action, pursuant to HRS § 269-16(d).⁵

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. The Parties' request to extend the deadline date, from December 27, 2004 to January 4, 2005, to file their settlement agreement, if any, is approved.

2. The Parties' corresponding request to extend the deadline date, from February 15, 2005 to February 23, 2005, to

comply with the nine (9)-month deadline governing commission action set forth in HRS § 269-16(d), is approved.




